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**Skill level: Intermediate**

**Designer: Barb Mapes**

**Cutting:**

WOF- width of the fabric, from selvage to selvage

HST – half square triangle

QST – quarter square triangle

**20913 BV-** Fussy cut 3 panels, 9 ½" x 11 ½"

**20916 G-** Cut 1 strip, 6 ½" x WOF, sub cut 1 - 6 ½" square

**20917 G-** Cut 1 strip, 6 ½" x WOF, sub cut 1 - 6 ½" square

Cut 5 strips, 2 ¼" x WOF, sub cut 2 strips 2 ¼" x 40".

Join remaining 3 strips together, sub cut into 2 strips, 2 ¼" x 48 ½"

**20918 E-** Cut 2 strips, 2 ½" x WOF, sub cut 4 - 12" rectangles

Cut 1 strip, 3 ½" x WOF, sub cut 8 - 3 ½" squares

Cut 1 strip, 3 ¾" x WOF, sub cut 8 - 3 ¾" squares. Cut each square diagonally to yield 16 HST

Cut 6 strips, 2 ½" x WOF

Cut 2 strip, 14 ¼" x WOF, cut 3- 14 ¼" squares, cut each square twice on the diagonal to yield 12

QST

(only 10 will be used.)

Cut 1 strip, 7 3/8" x WOF, cut 4 - 7 3/8" squares, cut each square diagonally to yield 8 HST

**20918 N-** Cut 1 strip, 11 ½" x WOF, cut 6 - 2" rectangles from the strip. Trim strip width to 10 ½" and sub cut 2 - 6 ½" rectangles from the remainder of the strip.

Cut 1 strip, 3 7/8" x WOF, sub cut into 4- 3 7/8" squares, cut each square diagonally to yield 8 HST

Cut 2 strips, 14 ¼" x WOF, sub cut into 4 - 14 ¼" squares, cut each square twice on the diagonal to yield 16 QST

(only 14 will be used.) Trim strip width to 12 ½", cut 6 - 3" rectangles from the remainder of the strip.

**21027 R-** cut 6 strips, 2 ½" x WOF

Cut 1 strip, 3 ¾" x WOF, sub cut into 4 - 3 ¾" squares, cut each square diagonally to yield 8 HST

Cut 1 strip, 7" x WOF, sub cut into 4 - 7" squares

Cut 6 strips, 2 ½" x WOF, join strips for binding

**20914 B-** (backing) cut 2 pieces of fabric 1 ½ yards long. With right sides together, sew along the selvage edge using a 1" seam allowance. Trim seam to ½" and press open.

**Block Assembly** *Note: All seam allowances are ¼" unless otherwise specified*

**Panel Block (finished size 12" x 16")**

Sew the 2 - 2" x 11 ½" rectangles to the sides of the 9 ½" x 11 ½" panel blocks. Press the seams towards the strip. Attach the 2 - 3" x 12 ½" rectangles to the top and bottom of the block. Press the seams towards the strip.

**Star Block (finished size 12" x 16")**

1-Sew the 8 cream triangles to the 8 blue triangles to make 4 Half square triangle (HST) units. Sew the 8 cream triangles to the 8 red triangles to make 4 HST units.

2-Sew 1 pair of red/cream HST units together to make a double HST unit, as shown below. Repeat with the other pair of red/cream HST units and with the 2 pairs of blue/cream HST units. You will have two double HST triangle units for both color combinations.

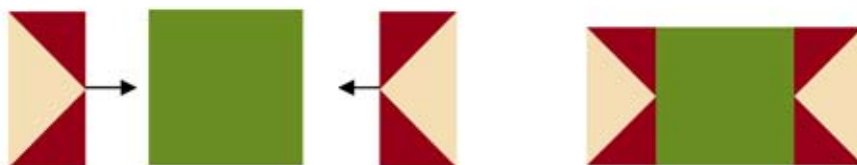


Double HST unit

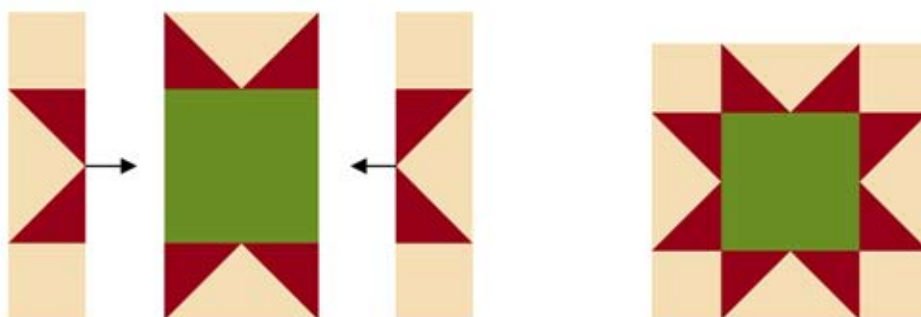
3-Attach a cream  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square to the sides of 2 red/cream double HST units. Press the seam towards the square. Repeat with 2 of the blue/cream double HST units. Press the seams towards the squares. Set these aside.



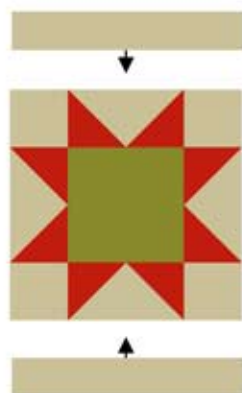
4-Attach the remaining pair of red/cream double HST units to each side of the green 20917 G block. Press the seam towards the green square. Attach the remaining pairs of blue/cream double HST units to each side of the green 20916 G block. Press the seams towards the green squares.



5-Sew the rows together as shown below. Press the seam away from the green square.



5-Attach a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12" strip to the top and bottom of each star block. Press the seam towards the strip.



### Flag Block ( finished size 12"x 32")

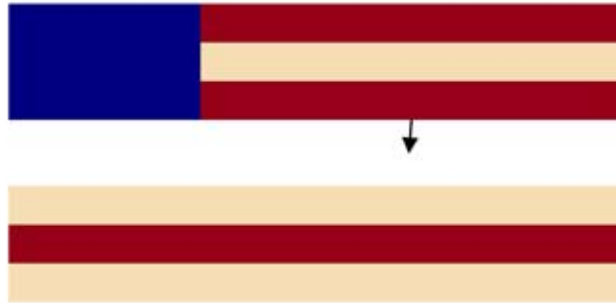
1- Make 2 strip sets, each using 1 -  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " cream strip and 2 -  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " red strips. Place the cream strip between the 2 red strips. Trim these to be  $22\frac{1}{2}$ " long. Set aside.

2- Make 2 strip sets, each using 1 -  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " red strip and 2 -  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " cream strips. Place the red strip between the 2 cream strips. Trim these to be  $32\frac{1}{2}$ " long. Set aside.

3-Using the 2 -  $22\frac{1}{2}$ " red/cream/red strip sets, attach a  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " blue rectangle to the short end of each strip set. Press the seam towards the blue rectangle.



4-Sew the **cream/red/cream** strip set unit to the blue with the stripes unit along the long side as shown.



### Quilt Top assembly:

1-Sew the blocks together as shown in the quilt image.

2- Inner border; Take the 2 green,  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $48\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, sew these to the sides of the quilt top. Press the seam towards the strips. Now take the 2 green,  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x 40" strips, sew these to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press the seam towards the strips.

3-Outer zig zag border; to make the saw tooth border, using the large blue and cream triangles, sew the short sides of the triangles together, alternating between blue and cream triangles. Use 4 blue and 3 cream triangles to make the long sides and use 3 blue and 2 cream triangles for the short sides. Repeat this step so you have 2 long sides and 2 short sides. Next, attach the small cream triangles to the ends of the 4 zig zag borders, as shown.



6- Sew the red  $7$ " x  $7$ " squares to the ends of the long (4 blue & 3 cream) border. Press the seams towards the squares. Set these 2 border units aside.



7- Sew the shorter border units (3 blue & 2 creams) to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press the seam towards the quilt top. Sew the long border units (4 blue & 3 creams) with the red square to the sides of the quilt top. Press the seams towards the quilt top.

Layer, quilt as desired and bind.
