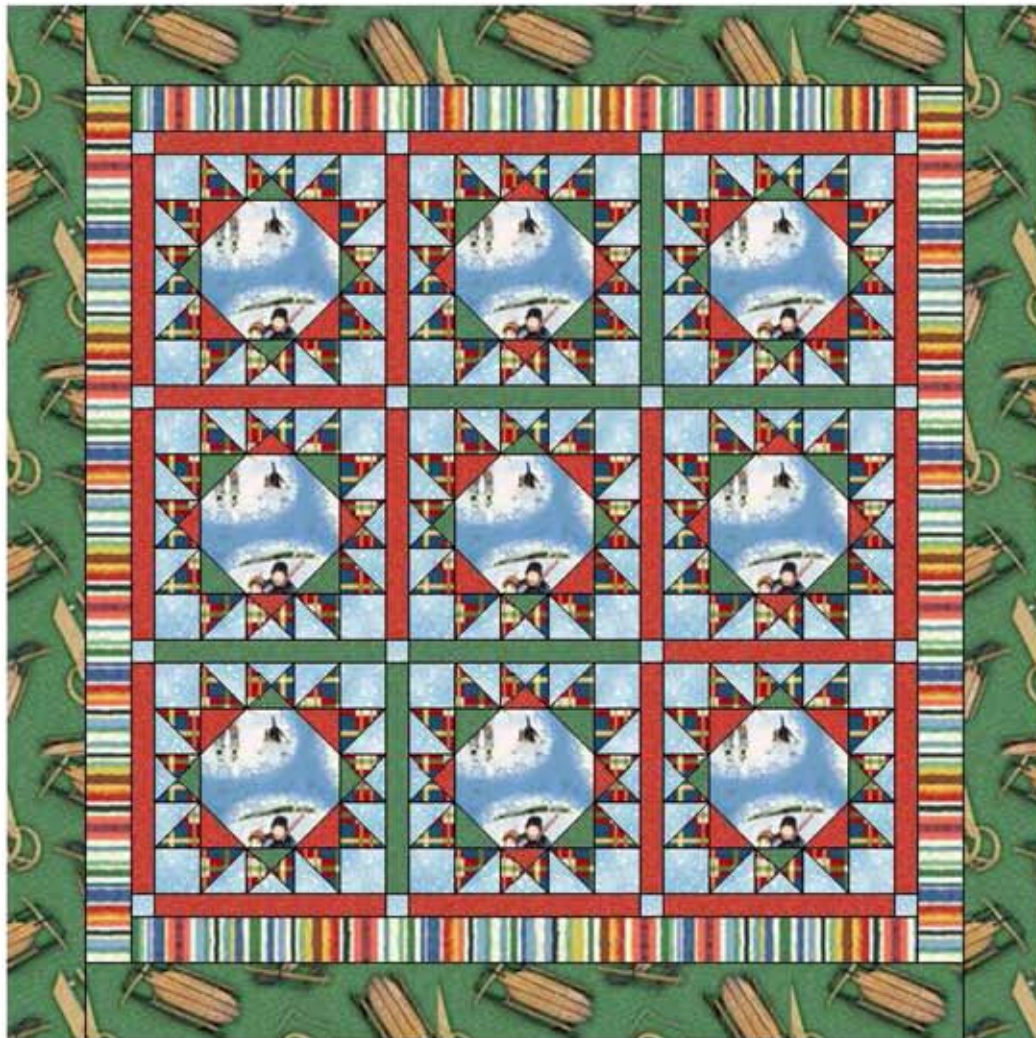

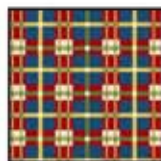

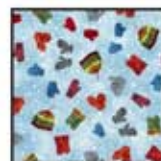

*To fussy cut 9 - Winter Fun motifs

Winter Fun

Quilt Size: 45" x 45"

Skill Level: Advanced Beginner/Intermediate

Cutting Directions:

From sledding motif print (21711B), fussy cut nine 6 ½" squares that encompasses complete sledding motifs (note: For ease of illustration only one motif is shown. You will cut a variety of motifs as shown in finished quilt image.)

From green solid fabric, cut

1. two 1 ½" x WOF strips – subcut into six 1 ½" x 10 ½" rectangles
2. one 3 ¼" x WOF strip – subcut into five 3 ¼" squares, cut again twice diagonally to yield twenty QST's
3. one 2 ½" x WOF strip – subcut into sixteen 2 ½" squares

From tartan fabric, cut

1. three 2 7/8" x WOF strips – recut into thirty six 2 7/8" squares
2. two 3 ¼" x WOF strips – recut into eighteen 3 ¼" squares, cut again twice diagonally to yield 72 QST's

From blue snow fabric, cut

1. one 1 ½" x WOF strip – recut into sixteen 1 ½" squares
2. three 2 7/8" x WOF strips – recut into thirty-six 2 7/8" squares
3. one 3 ¼" x WOF strip – recut into nine 3 ¼" squares, cut again twice diagonally to yield 36 QST's
4. three 2 ½" x WOF strips - recut into 36 2 ½" squares

From red solid fabric, cut

1. five 1 ½" x WOF strips – recut into eighteen 1 ½" x 10 ½" rectangles
2. two 2 ½" x WOF strips – recut into twenty 2 ½" squares
3. one 3 ¼" x WOF strip – recut into four 3 ¼" squares, cut again twice diagonally to yield 16 QST's

From stripe fabric, cut

1. four 2 ½" x WOF strips – recut into two 2 ½" x 38 ½" rectangles, and two 2 ½" x 34 ½" rectangles
2. four 2" x WOF strips – to be pieced to make a long continuous binding strip

From green sleigh fabric, cut

1. five 4" x WOF strips – recut into two of the strips into two 4" x 38 ½" rectangles. Cut sections from one the strips to piece with the remaining two strips to make two 4" x 45 ½" rectangles

Block Assembly:

Use ¼" seam allowance throughout, unless otherwise indicated. Sew pieces with right sides together, matching raw edges.

1. Draw a diagonal line across the back of a 2 ½" green solid square. Lay the square on a corner of a 6 ½" sledding motif square, right sides together. Sew on drawn line. Trim ¼" away from the sewn line. Press and open to reveal triangle. Repeat for the rest of the corners on the sledding motif square.



2. Draw a diagonal line across the back of a 2 7/8" blue snow square. Lay it on a 2 7/8" tartan square, right sides together. Sew ¼" away from both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line to yield two HST's unit. Press and open. Repeat to make a total of eight HST units.



3. Referring to the diagram, sew together the QST pieces from the blue snow, tartan and red pieces. Making a total of four units.



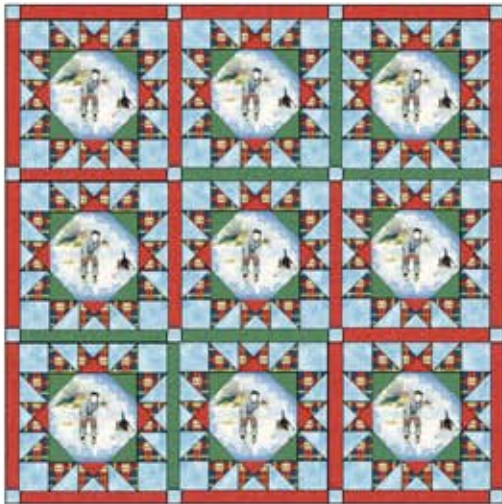
4. Refer to the following block assembly diagram, arrange and sew the pieces together. Repeat to make a total of four blocks. Repeat the block construction process, this time, substituting the red for green, and green for red, and make a total of five blocks.



Winter Fun

Quilt Assembly:

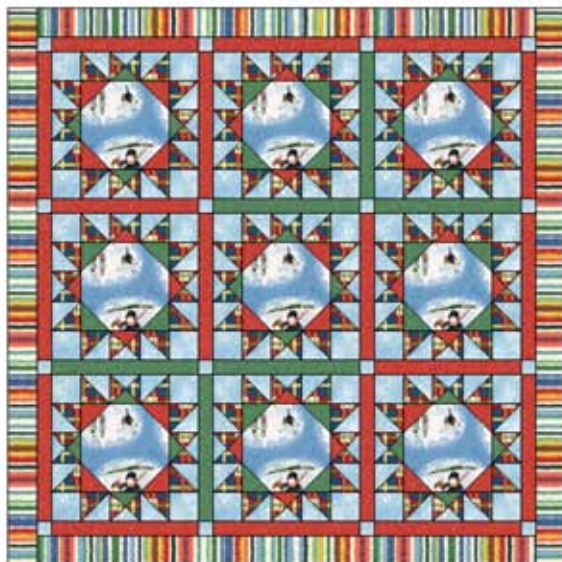
1. Referring to the quilt center diagram, sew three blocks and four red or green $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 10\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangles together into a row. Repeat to sew a total of three rows.



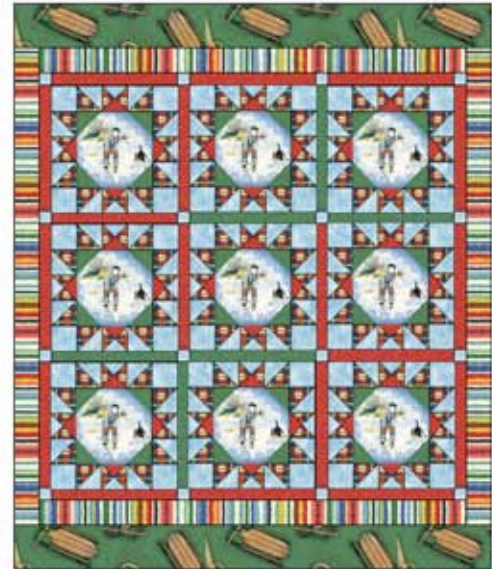
2. Also, referring to the quilt center diagram (shown above), sew three red or green $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 10\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangles and four blue snow $1\frac{1}{2}''$ squares together into a row. Repeat to make a total of four rows.

3. Refer again to the quilt center diagram, arrange and sew the rows together.

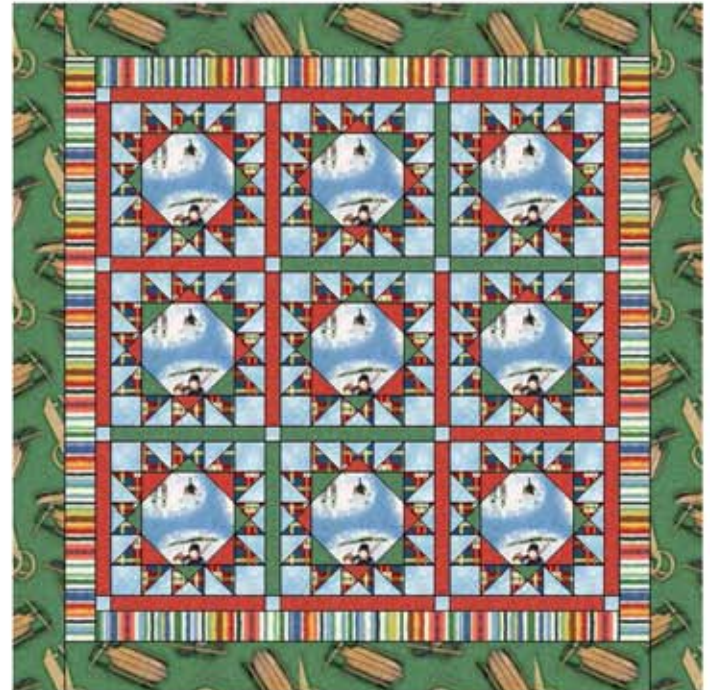
4. Sew two stripe print $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 34\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangles to the opposite sides of the quilt center. Sew the remaining two stripe print $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 38\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangles to the remaining opposite sides.



5. Sew two green sleigh $4'' \times 38\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangles to the opposite sides of the quilt center.



6. Sew the remaining two green sleigh $4'' \times 45\frac{1}{2}''$ border rectangles onto the remaining opposite sides.



Finishing:

1. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing to make a quilt sandwich. Baste the layers together. Quilt as desired. Trim backing and batting so that they are even with the quilt top.

2. Bind with stripe print binding strip.
