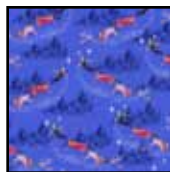

Finished Size: 60" x 70"

### Cutting Directions:

WOF = Width of fabric

#### #21868J (Black Print)

Cut (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips and join strips to make 280" of binding.

Cut (7) 4 ½" x WOF strips; join strips using diagonal seams, Cut (2) 4 ½" x 62 ½" and Cut (2) 4 ½" x 60 ½" strips for the fifth (final) border.

Cut (4) 4 ¼" x WOF strips; Cut (2) 4 ¼" x 35 ½" and cut (2) 4 ¼" x 25 ½" strips for second border.

Cut (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip; Cut (4) 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares.

Cut once diagonally to create (8) triangles for Block 2.

Cut (2) 1 ¾" x WOF strips; Cut (2) 1 ¾" x 13" strips and cut (2) 1 ¾" x 15 ½" strips for black border in center of quilt.

Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip; Cut (4) 3" x 3" squares for Block 3

Cut (2) 1 ¾" x WOF strips, sub cut (32) 1 ¾" squares for Block 3

#### #21866Y (Children Flying)

Cut (6) 4 ¼" x WOF strips; Cut (2) 4 ¼" x 55" and cut (2) 4 ¼" x 52 ½" strips for top and bottom of fourth (next to last) border

#### #21869G (Green Tinkerbell)

Cut (4) 3 ½" x WOF strips; Cut (2) 3 ½" x 35 ½" strips and cut (2) 3 ½" x 25 ½" strips for top and bottom of third border.

#### #21869V (Pink Tinkerbell)

Cut (4) 3 ½" x WOF strips; Cut (2) 3 ½" x 35 ½" strips and cut (2) 3 ½" x 25 ½" strips for top and bottom of first border.

Cut (2) 1 ⅞" x WOF strips; Cut (2) 1 ⅞" x 10 ¼" strips and cut (2) 1 ⅞" x 13" strips for pink border in center of quilt.

Cut (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips; Cut (20) 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares. Cut once diagonally to create (40) half square triangles for Block 1 and 2.

#### #21947B (Blue Stars)

Cut (1) 4" x WOF strips; Cut (8) 4" x 4" squares for Block 1.

Cut (1) 5 ½" x WOF strips; Cut (2) 5 ½" x 5 ½" squares.

#### #21867V (Skyline)

Cut (2) 5 ½" x WOF strips; Cut (8) 5 ½" x 5 ½" squares; Cut (2) 1 ¾" x WOF strips; sub cut (16) 1 ¾" squares for Block 3; sub cut (16) 1 ¾" x 3" rectangles for Block 3

#### #21870G (Top Hats/Bears)

Cut (1) 4" x WOF strips; Cut (4) 4" x 4" squares for Block 2.

#### #21864 GV (Panel)

Fussy cut (5) 10 ¼" x 10 ¼" Panel Scenes.

### Instructions:

#### Block 1

1. Sew (2) Pink Tinkerbell triangles to opposite sides of (1) Blue Stars 4" x 4" square.

2. Sew two additional Pink Tinkerbell triangles to the remaining sides of the square to complete Block 1. Make a total of (8) Block 1. Trim blocks to measure 5 ½" x 5 ½" square. Set these aside for pieced borders.



#### Block 2

1. Sew (2) Pink Tinkerbell triangles to the adjacent sides of (1) Top Hats/Bears 4" x 4" square.

2. Add (2) Black Print triangles to the remaining two sides of the square to create Block 2. Make total of (4) Block 2. Trim blocks to measure 5 ½" x 5 ½" square. Set these aside for pieced borders.

## Block 3

- (4) Star Blocks are needed. Mark a diagonal line on the back of the (32) Black print  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " squares.
- Place a  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " Black Print square atop the left half of a Skyline  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x 3" rectangle. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim excess seam allowance and press remainder toward the outer triangle. Repeat with another square on the opposite half. 1 Flying Geese completed. Make 16 Flying Geese Units.



- Sew a Flying Geese unit to each side of a 3" Black Print Square. Press the seams towards the center.



- Sew a Skyline  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " square to each side of a Flying Geese Unit. Make 8. Press the seams away from the center.



- Sew the units completed above to complete Block 3 as shown below. Note orientation of Flying Geese (refer to image below.) Make (4) Blocks. Trim as needed and be certain that the final measurement is  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ ". Set these aside for the pieced border.



## Quilt Center - Add Borders:

- Sew first (2) Pink Tinkerbell  $1\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{4}$ " border strips to a fussy cut  $10\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{4}$ " Panel block to make the quilt center. Sew (2)  $1\frac{7}{8}$ " x 13" strips of Pink Tinkerbell to top and bottom of the quilt center. Press the seams away from the center.

- Next, sew (2) Black Print side borders  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x 13" to the sides of the quilt center. Sew (2)  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $15\frac{1}{2}$ " borders to the top and to the bottom edges of the quilt center. Press the seams away from the center.

## Pieced Borders:

- Sew (1) Block 2 and (2) Skyline blocks together as shown below.



- Sew these to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Note: Be careful that the Black Print pieces of Block 2 are placed adjacent to the Black Print border strip. Press the seams towards the center.

- Assemble (2) pieced borders containing (5) blocks each as shown below.



- Sew these border strips to the sides of the quilt top center. Note: Be careful that the Black Print pieces of Block 2 are placed adjacent to the Black Print border strip. Press the seams towards the center.

- Assemble (2) more pieced borders containing (5) blocks each as shown below.



- Sew these border strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press the seams towards the center.

### Rail Border with Corner blocks:

1. Piece (2) border strip sets; Use (1) 3 ½" x 35 ½" Pink Tinkerbell, (1) 4 ¼" x 35 ½" Black Print, and (1) 3 ½" x 35 ½" Green Tinkerbell for each border strip set. Press



the seams towards the black print strips.

2. Sew these strip sets to the sides of the quilt center; the pink strip should be closest to the center. Press the seams towards the pink strip.

3. Piece (2) border strip sets; Use (1) 3 ½" x 25 ½" Pink Tinkerbell, (1) 4 ¼" x 25 ½" Black Print, and (1) 3 ½" x 25 ½" Green Tinkerbell for each border strip set. Press the seams towards the black print strips. See the image above.

4. Add a fussy cut 10 ¼" x 10 ¼" Panel block, to each end of the (2) border strip sets. See the image below.



Press the seams towards the strip set.

5. Sew these to the top and bottom of the quilt top center. Press the seams towards the pink strip.

### Children flying fabric Border:

1. Sew the Children Flying 4 ¼" x 55" strips to the sides of the quilt top. Press the seams away from the center.

2. Sew the Children Flying 4 ¼" x 52 ½" strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press the seams away from the center.

### Black Print Border:

3. Sew the Black Print 4 ½" x 62 ½" strips to each side of quilt center. Press the seams away from the center.

4. To complete this part of the quilt, sew the Black Print 4 ½" x 60 ½" strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press the seams away from the center.

Layer, quilt and bind, as desired.
