MEOW MEOW TABLE RUNNER

Skill level – Advanced beginner

Cutting:

From 25687 S_P – Cut 1 piece 11" square. Cut in half diagonally to form two triangles.

From 25689 G – Cut 2 pieces 6" square and cut in half diagonally to form 4 (C, D) triangles. Cut 4 pieces 4 ½" square and cut in half diagonally to form 8 (A, F, G) triangles.

From 25719 P – Cut 1 piece 5 ½" x 15". Reserve remainder for backing.

From 25688 P – Cut 4 cat blocks, 5" x 5", 2 orange floral blocks, 5" x 5", 4 pieces from the blue fish blocks, 3 ½" x 5", and 4 pieces from the violet blocks, 2 ½" x 5". Cut 2 strips 1 ½" x 15" from the pink print area.

Also needed – Batting

Construction:

Sew with ¼" seam allowance and all fabrics right sides together. Press each seam toward the darker fabric as you sew.

1. Sew 2 block strips with the blue, violet and orange pieces as shown below.



2. Sew one block strip to one side of the 5½" wide pink strip. Sew the remaining block strip to the other side of the pink strip.

3. Sew a 1½" wide pink strip to the remaining side edge of the block strip. Repeat on the other side.



4. Assemble the small (A, F,G) green triangle pieces and the large (D, C) green triangle pieces to the cat block pieces as shown below. Sew ABC together. Sew DEF together. Sew these two strips together. Sew a G piece to each end. Repeat for all the cat blocks. **See the photo for placement of the blocks and the green pieces.**



5. Sew a cat block strip to each side the block created in paragraph 3. Sew the base of the large patch triangle to each end.

6. Cut back and batting to match the top. Layer the back right side up, the batting and the top, right side down. Pin edges. Sew together, leaving a 6" opening along one edge. Trim points. Turn right side out and press. Slipstitch the opening closed.

7. Quilt as desired.
