### CUTTING DIRECTIONS

#### 22011 J - Gone With the Wind panel:

- Fussy cut (1) 23 ½" x 40 ½" rectangle for center of quilt

#### 22012 M - Red oval portraits print:

- Cut (2) 5 ½" x 75 ½" strips along the length of the fabric for fourth border.
- Cut (2) 5 ½" x 62 ½" strips along the length of the fabric for fourth border.

#### 22013 H - Light green floral:

- Cut (12) 2" x 42" strips for the first and third borders.

#### 22016 K - Black/gray print:

- Cut (6) 3 ½" x 42" strips for the second border.
- Cut (8) 2 ½" x 42" strips for binding.

#### 22015 G - Green filigree:

- Cut (2) 3" x 42" strips; recut into (16) 3" squares for B blocks.
- Cut (2) 3 ⅜" x 42" strips; recut into (24) 3 ⅜" squares. • Cut the squares in half diagonally to make (48) triangles for B blocks.

#### 22015 M - Pink filigree:

- Cut (2) 3" x 42" strips; recut into (16) 3" squares for B blocks.
- Cut (2) 3 ⅜" x 42" strips; recut into (24) 3 ⅜" squares. • Cut the squares in half diagonally to make (48) triangles for B blocks.

#### 22015 J - Black/gold filigree:

- Cut (2) 4" x 42" strips; recut into (4) 4" x 10 ½" strips and (4) 4" x 7" strips for A blocks.
- Cut (1) 4" x 42" strip; recut into (8) 4" squares for B blocks.
- Cut (3) 3 ⅜" x 42" strips; recut into (32) 3 ⅜" squares. • Cut the squares in half diagonally to make (64) triangles for C blocks.

#### 22016 E - Cream print:

- Cut (1) 6 ¼" x 42" strip; recut into (4) 6 ¼" squares and (4) 4" squares. Cut the 6 ¼" squares twice diagonally to make (16) triangles for C blocks.
- Cut (1) 3 ⅜" x 42" strip; recut into (8) 3 ⅜" squares.
- Cut the squares in half diagonally to make (16) triangles for C blocks.

#### 22016 S - Gold print:

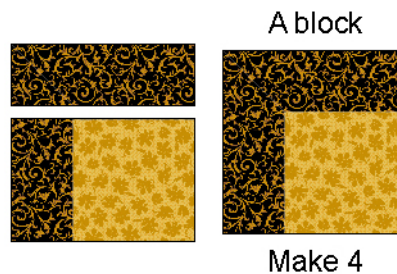
- Cut (1) 7" x 42" strip; recut into (4) 7" squares for A blocks.
- Cut (3) 3 ⅜" x 42" strips; recut into (32) 3 ⅜" squares.
- Cut the squares in half diagonally to make (64) triangles for B blocks.

#### 22013 S - Gold Magnolia:

- Cut (2) 93" lengths for backing.

### A BLOCK

1. Select all pieces cut for the A blocks.
2. Sew a 4" x 7" black/gold strip to one side of a 7" gold floral print square. Press seam toward the strip.
3. Sew a 4" x 10 ½" black strip to the bottom to complete (1) 10 ½" x 10 ½" A block. Press seam toward the strip.
4. Repeat to make a total of 4 A blocks.

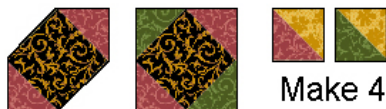


### B BLOCK

1. Select all pieces cut for the B blocks.
2. Sew a pink triangle to opposite sides of a 4" black/gold square. Press seams toward the triangles. Repeat with green triangles on the remaining sides of the square to complete the block center. Press

seams toward the triangles.

3. Sew a pink triangle to a gold triangle. Press seam toward the pink triangle. Repeat to make 4 pink units. Repeat with green and gold triangles to make 4 green units. Press seams toward the green triangles.

4. Sew a pink unit to a green unit to make a pieced strip. Press seam toward the green unit. Repeat to make a second pieced strip. Repeat to make 2 reversed pink strips.

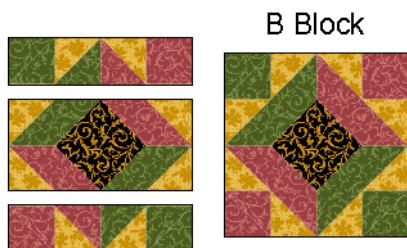

5. Sew a pieced strip to opposite sides of the block center to make the center strip. Press seams toward the block center.

6. Add a pink square to 1 end and a green square to the remaining end of a reversed pieced strip to make the top strip. Press seams toward the squares. Repeat to make the bottom strip.

7. Sew the center strip between the top and bottom strips to complete (1) 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" B block. Press seams toward the top and bottom strips.

8. Repeat to make a total of 8 B blocks.

## BLOCK C

1. Select all pieces cut for the C blocks.

2. Sew a black/gold triangle to opposite sides of a 4" cream square. Press seams toward the triangles. Sew a black/gold triangle to the remaining sides of the square to complete the block center. Press seams toward the triangles.

3. Sew a black/gold triangle to each short side of a 6 1/4" cream triangle to make a side unit. Press seams toward the black/gold triangles. Repeat to make a total of 4 side units.

4. Sew a black/gold triangle to a 3 3/8" cream triangle to make a corner unit. Press seam toward the black/gold triangle. Repeat to make a total of 4 corner units.

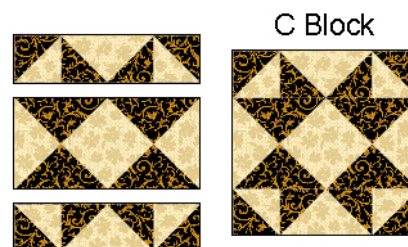

5. Sew the block center between 2 side units to make the center row. Press seams toward the side units.

6. Sew a side unit between 2 corner units to make the top row. Press seams toward the side unit. Repeat to make the bottom row.

7. Sew the center row between the top and bottom rows to complete (1) 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" C block. Press seams toward the center row.

8. Repeat to make a total of 4 C blocks.

## Quilt Assembly

1. Join two B blocks and add an A block to each end to make a row. Press seams to the left. Repeat to make a second row. Join two C blocks and add a B block to each end to make a row. Press seams to the right. Repeat to make a second row.

2. Referring to the quilt photo for positioning, sew one of each B/C row to the top and bottom of the panel rectangle. Sew one of each A/B row to the top and bottom of the B/C rows to complete the 40 1/2" x 63 1/2" quilt center. Press seams toward the panel rectangle.

3. Join the 2" x 42" light green floral strips on the short ends to make a long strip. Press seams to one side. Cut into (2) 63 1/2", (2) 43 1/2", (2) 72 1/2" and (2) 52 1/2" strips. Sew the 63 1/2" strips to the long sides of the quilt center and the 43 1/2" strips to the top and bottom. Press seams toward the strips. Set aside the remaining strips for step 5.

4. Join the 3 1/2" x 42" black/gray print strips on the short ends to make a long strip. Press seams to one side. Cut into (2) 66 1/2" and (2) 49 1/2" strips. Sew the longer strips to the long sides and the shorter strips to the top and bottom. Press seams toward the strips.

5. Sew the 72 1/2" light green floral strips to the long sides and the 52 1/2" strips to the top and bottom. Press seams toward the strips.

6. Sew the 5 1/2" x 75 1/2" red oval portraits print strips to the long sides and the 5 1/2" x 62 1/2" strips to the top and bottom. Press seams toward the strips to complete the quilt top.

7. Remove the selvage edges from the backing pieces. Join the pieces on the long edges with a 1/2" seam allowance. Press seam open. Trim the side edges to make a 70" x 93" backing piece.

8. Layer, quilt and bind, using your favorite methods and the black/gray print binding strips, to complete the quilt.
