## MATERIALS

- 1 panel 21350 B
- ½ yard 21357 B blue swirl fabric
- ½ yard 21355 P pink star confetti fabric
- 1¼ yard 21357 R pink swirl fabric
- ⅜ yard 21357 S yellow swirl fabric
- 3¼ yards 21353 S yellow bubbles- backing

**NOTE:** Unless otherwise noted, all seam allowances are ¼".  
WOF= Width of Fabric

## CUTTING FABRIC

**21350 B** Trim the panel to measure 34 ¾" x 42 ½"

### 21357 B Blue Swirls Fabric

Cut 2 strips @ 5 ¼" x WOF, sub cut into 11- 5 ¼" squares. Cut each square diagonally twice to yield 4 quarter-square-triangles. You will have a total of 44 quarter-square-triangles.

### 21357 S Yellow Swirls Fabric

Cut 2 strips @ 5 ¼" x WOF strips, sub cut into 10- 5 ¼" squares. Cut each square diagonally twice to yield 4 quarter-square-triangles. You will have a total of 40 quarter-square-triangles. Project will only use 38 quarter-square-triangles.

### 21357 R Pink Swirls Fabric

Cut 2 strips @ 5 ¼" x WOF strips, sub cut into 10- 5 ¼" squares. Cut each square diagonally twice to yield 4 quarter-square-triangles. Project will only use 38 quarter-square-triangles. Cut 5 strips @ 2" x WOF strips, sub cut 2 strips @ 2" x 34 ¾". Sew the remaining 3 strips together and cut 2 strips @ 2" x 45 ½" strips. Cut 5 strips @ 2 1/8" x WOF strips, piece together to form a continuous binding strip.

### 21355 P Pink Star Confetti Fabric

Cut 2 strips @ 5 ¼" x WOF, sub cut into 10- 5 ¼" squares. Cut each square diagonally twice to yield 4 quarter-square-triangles. You will have a total of 40 quarter-square-triangles.

### 21353 S Yellow Bubbles Fabric

Cut 2 pieces 58" long, sew the two pieces of backing fabric together, along the selvage, use a 1" seam. Trim the selvage to ½" and press the seam open.

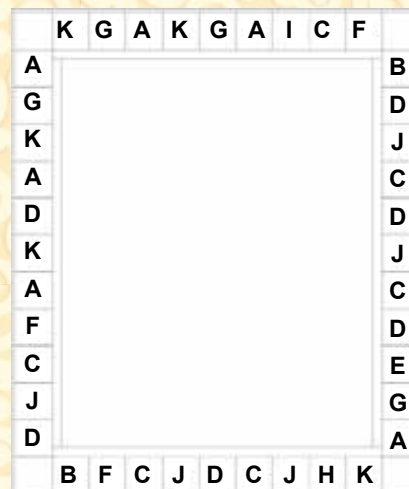
## CONSTRUCTING QUILT TOP

### Inner Border & Block border

**STEP 1:** Sew a 2" x 34 ¾" pink swirl strip to the top and the bottom of the panel. Sew the 2" x 45 ½" pink swirl strips to the sides of the panel. Trim the pink borders to a finished size of 36 ½" x 44 ½"

**STEP 2:** Follow the diagram at right to sort the triangles into the quarter-square triangle blocks. Sew the triangles together to form the blocks. You should have 40 blocks. Finished block size is 4 ½", including seam allowance.

**STEP 3:** Arrange the blocks as shown in the diagram below. Sew the blocks in the top row together. Sew the blocks in the bottom row together. Sew the blocks in the left side row together; add a 4 ½" pink swirl square to each end and sew the blocks in the right side row together; add a 4 ½" pink swirl square to each end. You'll have four block border strips, a top, a bottom and two sides.



**STEP 4:** Sew the top block border strip and the bottom block border strip to the quilt top. Now sew the side block border strips to the sides of the quilt. The pink star confetti, 21355 P, should be on the outside edge of the border.

**STEP 5:** If extra "poof" is desired for the animals and clown, cut pieces of wool or polyester batting to cover the animals or clown on the back of quilt panel, sew the batting using water soluble thread as top thread. Trim batting around the edge of the sewn shape of animals.

## FINISHING QUILT

1. Layer the quilt top right side up on top of the batting and the wrong side of the backing. Quilt as desired. Trim backing and batting even with quilt top.
2. Sew the pink swirl binding strip to the quilt using a ¼" seam. Fold to back and slipstitch.
