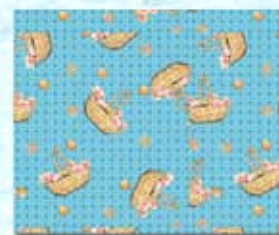

Skill Level: Intermediate, with knowledge of applique

*Read through instructions thoroughly before beginning. Seam allowance = 1/4" unless otherwise specified. WOF = Width of Fabric
For applique pieces, add 1/4" seam allowance for hand applique. Asterisk indicates cut first*

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

21477Q – Book Panel: Fussy-cut 12 book pages, 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" stack in page number order, starting with cover.

21481Q – Scattered bunnies on blue: Cut 8 strips, 2" x WOF. Further cut 31 rectangles, 2" x 9 1/2"

21483R – Baskets on red: Cut 1 strip, 2" x WOF
Further cut 20 squares, 2" x 2"

21483Q – Baskets on blue:

*Cut 4 – 5 1/2" strips. Sew 2 strips together at the 5 1/2" ends making 2 long strips and subcut those strips into 2 strips 5 1/2" x 56 1/2".

*Cut 4 – 5 1/2" strips. Sew 2 strips together at the 5 1/2" ends making 2 long strips and subcut those strips into 2 strips 5 1/2" x 52 1/2"

Cut 3 – 2 1/2" strips. Sew strips together at the 2 1/2" ends making one long strip and subcut into strips 2 1/2" x 43 1/2".

Cut 2 – 2 1/2" strips. Subcut these strips to 2 1/2" x 33 1/2"

21478QC – Stripe:

*Fussy cut 4 – 4 1/2" strips. Sew 2 strips together at the 4 1/2" ends making 2 long strips and subcut those strips into strips 4 1/2" x 47 1/2".

Fussy cut 4 – 4 1/2" strips. Sew 2 strips together at the 4 1/2" ends making 2 long strips and subcut those strips into 2 strips 4 1/2" x 42 1/2"

21484G – Green Mottle: 15" square

25552R – Red check: 1/8 Yard

Cut 10 of Template A

21484Q – Blue mottle: 1/3 Yard

Cut 10 of Template B

21484S – Yellow mottle: 1/8 Yard

Assemble Quilt Top

Refer to quilt image while assembling quilt top. Select (4) #21483R squares, 2" x 2", and (3) #21481Q rectangles, 2" x 9 1/2". Begin with 2" x 2" square and sew all pieces together into a row; make 5 rows. Next, select (4) #21481Q rectangles, 2" x 9 1/2" and the first 3 "pages" from your stack of #21477Q squares, 9 1/2" x 9 1/2". Begin with a 2" x 9 1/2" rectangle and sew all pieces together into a row. Continue making rows, paying close attention to the placement of your storybook "pages"; make 4 rows. Sew together all 9 rows to construct the center of your quilt top.

Sew #21483Q strips, 2 1/2" x 43 1/2", to each side of quilt top. Sew #21483Q strips, 2 1/2" x 33 1/2", to top and bottom of quilt top. Next, sew #21478QC fussy-cut strips, 4 1/2" x 47 1/2", to each side of quilt top. Sew #21478QC fussy-cut strips, 4 1/2" x 42 1/2", to top and bottom of quilt top. Sew #21483Q strips, 5 1/2" x 56 1/2", to each side of quilt top. Sew #21483Q strips, 5 1/2" x 52 1/2", to top and bottom of quilt top.

Instructions for Applique

Make bias strip for vine: Cut #21484G, 15" square, into 1 1/4" strips on the bias (45° angle). Sew strips together, then fold strip by matching up raw edges with wrong sides together. Sew strip along raw edges using 1/4" seam. Press flat with iron, hiding seam below.

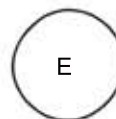
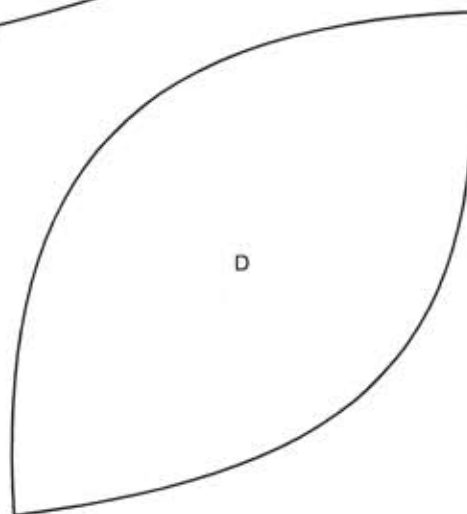
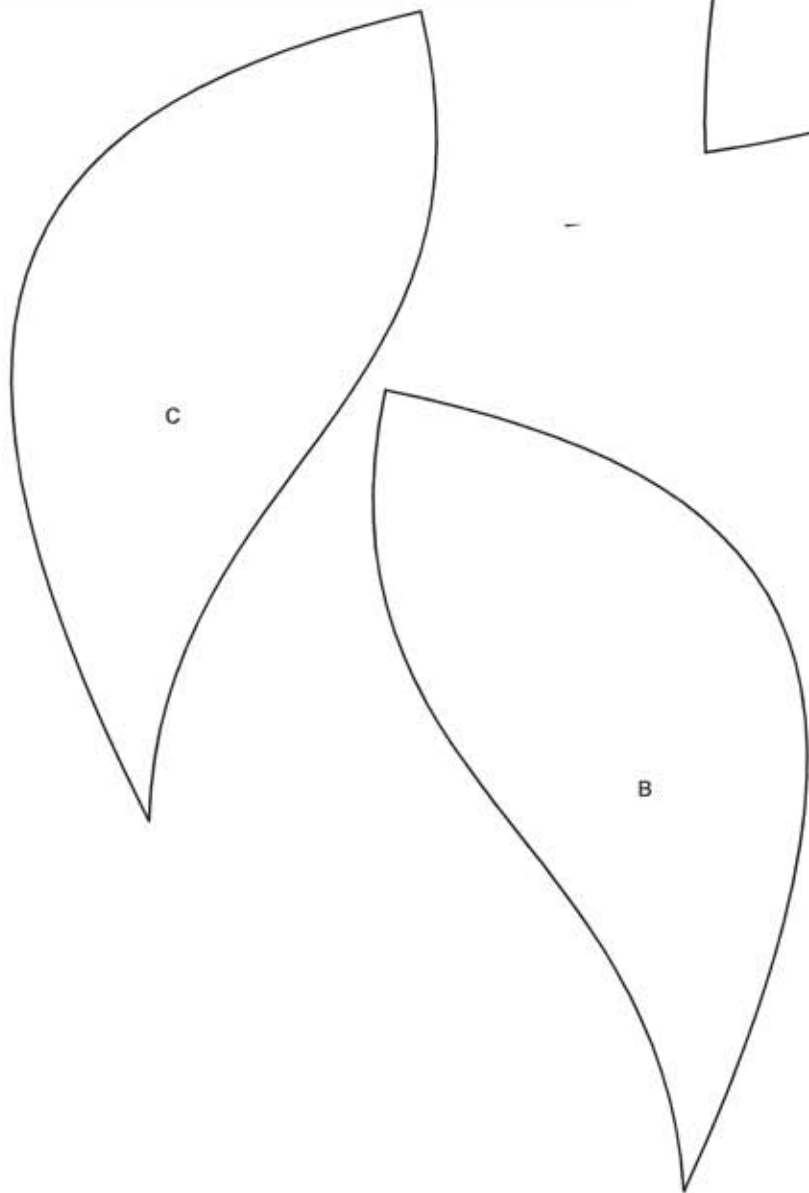
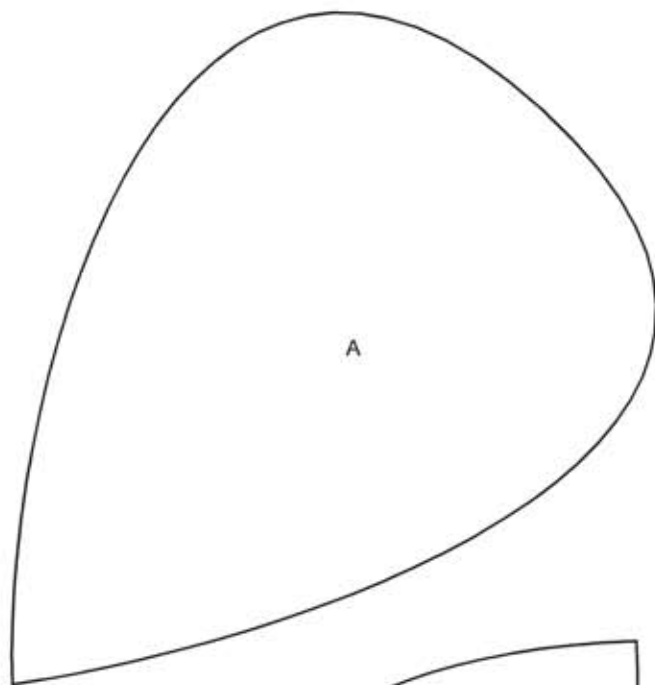
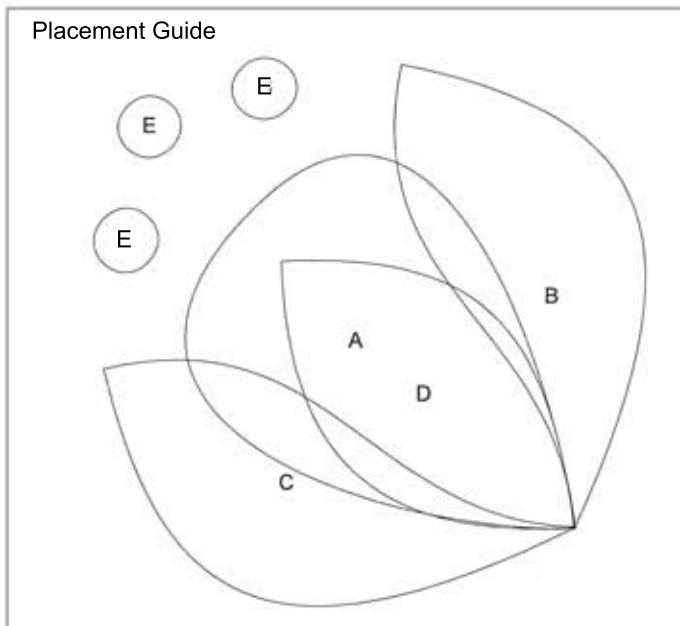
Using quilt image as a guide, pin bias strip in place to form vines as shown on border. Hand or machine applique in place. Pin Template A, #25552 R flower centers to quilt top; applique in place. For each flower, pin Template B (right) and Template C (left) petals to quilt top; applique in place, then pin Template D (center) petal to quilt top; applique in place. Finally, for each flower, pin three Template E pistils above each flower center; applique in place. Optional: Using pencil, lightly draw a curved line from the center of the flower to each pistil. Using black embroidery floss, stitch along drawn line using the stem stitch.

Sandwich quilt top, batting, and backing; quilt as desired. Add binding to finish quilt.
