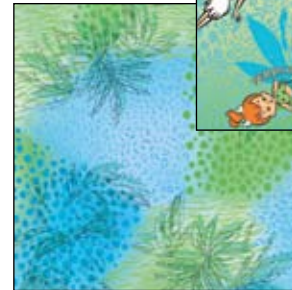




# Flintstones Lunch Bag, Napkin and Mat



25664-BG  
1 yard



25666-BG  
5/8 yard

## Materials

- 1 yard of main fabric 25664-BG (bag, napkins and mat)
- 5/8 yard of coordinating fabric 25666-BG (lining and utensil pocket)
- 2 inches of 1" wide hook and loop fastener tape
- Matching thread
- 1/2 yard iron-on interfacing

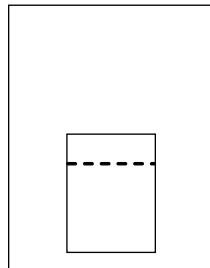
*Note: All seam allowances are 3/8" unless otherwise stated.*

## Cutting

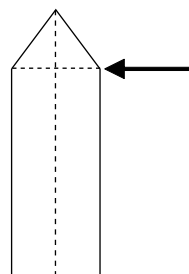
**Bag** - cut 2 rectangles measuring 15" x 12" from main fabric, cut 2 rectangles measuring 15" x 12" from lining fabric.

**Napkin and Utensil pocket** - cut 1 rectangle measuring 7" x 6" from lining fabric.

Turn side and bottom edges of utensil pocket in 1/2". Press. Turn top of utensil pocket in 1/4" and press. Turn under 1" and stitch close to hem. Pin utensil pocket right side up on right side of one larger lining rectangle as shown in illustration. Stitch on two sides and the bottom.



With right sides together, stitch sides of main color rectangles (bag). Sew the bottom of the rectangles together. With side seam on top, and bottom seam directly beneath, lay bag flat, creating triangle at side bottom. Stitch as shown in illustration to form the bottom of bag.



Trim to 3/8" and press seam toward center of bag. Turn the bag right side out, press well. Repeat with lining rectangles. Lay the lining inside bag right sides together. Stitch around top leaving a 2" open for turning. Turn the bag right side out. Slip stitch the opening closed. Tuck the lining into the lunch bag, press top of bag. Topstitch 1/4" from opening. Stitch or glue hook portion of hook and loop tape piece to center of one side of bag top, stitch or glue loop portion of hook and loop tape to other side of bag, centered and 3" below top of bag. Roll bag top and secure hook and loop tape to close bag.

## Napkin

From remaining yardage, cut a square 14" x 14". Turn in edges 1/4" and press. Turn in once again and press. Stitch closely along edges, pivoting carefully at corners. Press.

## Mat - finished size 11" x 17"

Cut 2 rectangles measuring 11 3/4" x 17 3/4". Cut iron-on interfacing to same size. Iron interfacing to wrong side of one rectangle following manufacturer's directions. Place rectangles right sides together and stitch around all sides leaving a 2" opening for turning. Turn right sides out and press well. Slipstitch opening closed. Topstitch 1/4" around outside edges of mat. Roll and place in utensil pocket of bag.
