Cutting

21648H Storybook Panel

Fussy cut all 10 pages of the story at $9\frac{3}{8}$ " x $9\frac{3}{8}$ "; centering images. Label each with its page number.

Fussy cut title page at 8" x 8"; centering images.

21649S Border Stripe

Border #2 Strips – Fussy cut farmyard print stripe along length of fabric as follows: 2 strips at $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $70\frac{1}{2}$ " and 2 strips at $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $53\frac{1}{2}$ "

21650H Overall Scenic Print

Cut 1 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip; subcut into 6 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, label F for Quarter Log Cabin blocks.

21651P Pink Duck Print

Cut 2 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips; subcut into 6 - $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, label E for Quarter Log Cabin blocks. Subcut remainder of $2\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide strips into 6 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, label F for Quarter Log Cabin blocks.

21651S Yellow Duck Print

Cut 3 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips; subcut into 6 - $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, label C for Quarter Log Cabin blocks. Subcut remainder of $2\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide strips into 6 - $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, label D for Quarter Log Cabin blocks.

Cut 1 - 4" x WOF strip; subcut into 4 - 4" x 4" squares, label B for Diamond in the Square corner block centers.

21652P White/Pink Toile Print

Cut 4 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips; subcut into 6 - $10\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, label B for Quarter Log Cabin blocks. Subcut remainder of $2\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide strips into 6 - $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, label C for Quarter Log Cabin blocks.

21653B Blue Duck Print

Cut 2 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips; subcut into 6 - $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, label D for Quarter Log Cabin blocks. Subcut remainder of $2\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide strips into 6 - $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, label E for Quarter Log Cabin blocks.

Cut 6 - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for Border #1.

21654B Blue Swirl Tonal

Cut 4 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips; subcut into 6 - $12\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, label A for Quarter Log Cabin blocks. Subcut remainder of $2\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide strips into 6 - $10\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, label B for Quarter Log Cabin blocks.

Cut 1 - $3\frac{3}{8}$ " strip, subcut into 8 - $3\frac{3}{8}$ " squares. Cut each square in half on 1 diagonal to make 16 triangles; label A for Diamond in the Square border #2 corner blocks.

Cut 9 - $2\frac{1}{8}$ " x WOF strip; subcut into 40 - $8\frac{1}{4}$ " strips; label B for Story blocks.

21654H Green Swirl Tonal

Cut 10 - $1\frac{1}{8}$ " x WOF strips; subcut into 40 - $9\frac{3}{8}$ " strips, label C for Story blocks.

Cut 1 - 1" x WOF strip; subcut 2 - 9" strips and 2 - 8" strips, for Title Page block.

Cut 1 - $6\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip; subcut into 2 - $6\frac{7}{8}$ " x $6\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut each square in half on 1 diagonal to make 4 triangles; label A for Title Page block.

21654P Pink Swirl Tonal

Cut 2 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips; subcut into 20 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Cut each square in half on 1 diagonal to make 40 triangles; label A for Story blocks.

Cut 1 - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip; subcut 4 - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for border #1 cornerstones.

21655BS Blue Stripe

Cut $2\frac{1}{4}$ "-wide strips on bias grain to total 300" for bias binding.

21655P Pink Stripe

Cut a $12\frac{7}{8}$ " square of template plastic. Position the template on the fabric so that stripe runs from point to point on the square. Cut a total of 7 identical squares. Cut each square in half on 1 diagonal taking care that stripes are correctly oriented to make 14 setting triangles. (See illustrations below)



5 yards backing fabric (21651S Yellow Duck Print)

Cut the backing into two equal lengths and join along selvage edges with a 1" seam. Trim selvage away and press seam open. Trim backing to 71" x 88".

Sewing Directions:

Quarter Log Cabin Blocks: Make 6

- Lay out fabric strips in order. Begin by sewing the F squares together, sew E next, and continue sewing in reverse alphabetical order to A. (Fig. 1) Press after the addition of each strip.

Story Blocks: Make 10

- Fold and crease each pink swirl tonal A triangle along long edge, and each blue swirl tonal B and green swirl tonal C strip along long side to mark the centers.
- Sew C to B to A, matching creased centers, to make an A-B-C unit; press seams toward A. Repeat to make a total of 40 A-B-C units.
- Center and sew an A-B-C unit to each side of a story book $9\frac{3}{8}$ " square; press seams away from story book square.
- Trim block to $12\frac{1}{2}$ ", taking care to center image. Repeat to make 10 Story Blocks.

Title Page Block: Make 1

- Sew a 1" x 8" green swirl tonal strip to each side of title page 8" square, press to center. Sew a 1" x 9" green strip to the top and bottom.
- Sew a green swirl tonal triangle to opposite sides of the center page, press seams toward triangles. Repeat on remaining sides to complete the block.
- Square block to $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ "

Diamond in the Square Border Cornerstones: Make 4 (5" x 5" finished size)

- Sew a $3\frac{3}{8}$ " blue swirl tonal triangle to opposite sides of the center square; press seams toward center. Repeat on remaining sides to complete the block, press seams toward center.

Quilt Center

- Referring to Fig. 2, lay out all blocks and side inset triangles in diagonal rows and join, being careful to keep story pages in order and upright. Press seams in

adjoining rows in opposite directions. Sew rows together diagonally, working from top left to bottom right, Press seams in one direction.

Note: *The side triangle edges are on the diagonal, be very careful not to stretch these. Applying spray starch to these edges help keep fabric stabilized.*

Border 1

- Join border #1 blue duck strips together on ends using diagonal seams, press. Cut 2 strips at $51\frac{1}{2}$ " and 2 strips at $68\frac{1}{2}$ ".
- Sew longer strips to opposite long sides of the pieced center; press seams toward strips. Sew the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " cornerstone squares to the ends of the shorter strips; press seams toward strips. Sew these strips to the top and bottom of the pieced center; press seams toward strips.

Border 2

- Sew the $70\frac{1}{2}$ " border #2 border stripe strips to opposite long sides of the pieced center; press seams toward strips.
- Sew the Cornerstone Blocks to each end of each $53\frac{1}{2}$ " border stripe strip; press seams toward strips. Sew these strips to the top and bottom of the pieced center to complete the quilt top; press seams toward strips.

Finishing

Layer, quilt as desired and bind.
