Cutting:

21058-B: Cut 1/4" around each of the 6 different animal motifs creating 6 units approximately 5 1/2" x 6 5/8".

21059-N: Cut three 3 1/2" strips by width of fabric (WOF) keeping the bubble motifs in the center.

21060-NR: Cut 1/4" on either side of the stars on the cow/barn border or any combination you like that equals 6 1/2" wide, following the selvage edge.

See figure 2.

21061-E: Cut four 4 1/2" strips by WOF, remaining fabric will be used for the Backing.

21062-B: Cut eight 2 1/2" strips by WOF. Sub cut into twelve 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" pieces and twelve 2 1/2" x 6 5/8" pieces

21062-RN: Cut eight 2 1/2" strips by WOF. Sub cut into twelve 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" pieces and twelve 2 1/2" x 6 5/8" pieces

21063-N: Cut four 2 1/2" strips by WOF and cut seven 2 1/2" by WOF for the Binding.

21064-B: Cut three 2 1/2" strips by WOF. Sub cut into forty four 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares.

21064-R: Cut three 2 1/2" strips by WOF. Sub cut into forty four 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares. Cut one strip 3 1/2" x WOF, sub cut four 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares

Sewing: All seams are 1/4" unless otherwise specified. Press all seams open.

Assemble Quilt Top

Sew a 21064-R square to each end of the 2 1/2" by 6 5/8" 21062-B rectangles (Unit A). Sew a 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" 21062-B rectangle to each side of a 21058-B motif (Unit B). Sew a Unit A to the top and bottom of Unit B to create Block A. Make 3.



Sew a 21064-B square to each end of the 2 1/2" by 6 5/8" 21062-RN rectangles (Unit C). Sew a 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" 21062-B rectangle to each side of a 21058-B motif (Unit D). Sew a Unit C to the top and bottom of Unit D to create Block B. Make 3.



Sew together one 21064-B 2 1/2" square to one 21064-R 2 1/2" square as in figure 1. Sew together two units to create a four-patch unit. Make 4.



Sew together a 21064-R 2 1/2" square to either side 21064-B 2 1/2" square as in figure 2. Sew together a 21064-B 2 1/2" square on either side of a 21064-R 2 1/2" square as in figure 3.

Sew units together to create a nine patch unit as below. Make 4.

To assemble the top, sew a Block A to left side of a Block B (Make 2). Sew a Block B to the left side of Block A.

Assemble as shown below to make Quilt Top Center.

Borders

Inner Border. Measure length and width of the Quilt Top Center. Cut two 21059-N strips the same measurement as the length and sew to either side of the Quilt Top Center (Figure 4). Cut two 21059-N strips the same measurement as the width Quilt Top Center. Sew a 21064-R 3½" square to each end of the strips. Sew to the top and bottom of the Quilt Top Center as in figure 5. Press.

First Border. Repeat the measuring of the quilt and cut two lengths and two widths of 21061-E. Repeat the assembly as above using the Four Patch Units, refer to quilt image for orientation of Four Patch Units. Press.

Second Border. Repeat the measuring of the quilt and cut two lengths and two widths of 21063-N. Repeat the assembly as above using the remaining four 2½" 21064-R squares. Press.

Outer Border. Repeat the measuring of the quilt and cut two lengths and two widths of 21060-NR. Repeat the assembly as above using the Nine Patch Units. Press.

Layer, quilt and bind.
