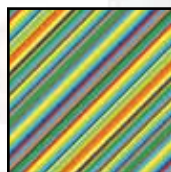

Note: Unless noted, measurements are given in inches and seam allowance is $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Strips are cut selvedge to selvedge.

MATERIALS NEEDED:

- 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ yard Blue Fireworks 21386 Y
- 1 yard Red Multi-Print 21384 O
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yard Green Veggies 21387 H
- 1 yard Red bricks 21505 R
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yard Stripes 21506 B
- 1 panel: Share the Year Together
- Fusible web
- 57" x 67" piece of batting
- 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ yards 21383 Y backing fabric
- 5 yards each of red, green, and blue ribbon

CUTTING AND FABRIC PREPARATION:

WOF=width of fabric

Blue Fireworks:

Cut 7 strips @ 4" x WOF. Sew two strips together along the 4" side, use a diagonal seam. Repeat with two more strips. Trim each long strip to 4" x 60" for the outer side border.

From the remaining strips sub cut 4 rectangles @ 4" x 22" for the side top/bottom border segments. If the strips a bit too short because of the selvedge then sew remaining strips together along the 4" side, use a diagonal seam. From this; sub cut the side top/bottom border segments.

From the leftover strips, sub cut 2 rectangles @ 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{4}$ ".

Cut 6 strips @ 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF, for the binding strips. Join the strips together

Red Multi-Print:

Cut 7 strips @ 4" x WOF. Sew two strips together along the 4" side, use a diagonal seam. Repeat with two other strips. Trim each strip to 4" x 60" for the middle side border.

Sew remaining strips together along the 4" side, use a diagonal seam. From this; sub cut 4 rectangles @ 4" x 22" for the middle top/bottom border segments.

Green Veggies:

Cut 6 strips @ 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Sew the strips together along the 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " side, use a diagonal seam. Sub cut 2 strips @ 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 60" for the inner side border and 4 strips @

2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" for the inner top/bottom border segments.

Red bricks:

Cut 8 strips @ 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Sub cut into 31 pcs @ 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{4}$ " sashing strips.

Cut 2 strips @ 4" x WOF. Sub cut into 4 rectangles @ 4" x 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ " and (4) 4 rectangles @ 4" x 11 $\frac{1}{4}$ " (kites).

Stripes:

Cut 2 strips @ 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Sub cut into 20 pcs @ 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " for the corner squares.

Cut 2 strips @ 4" x WOF. Sub cut into 4 rectangles @ 4" x 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ " and 4 rectangles @ 4" x 11 $\frac{1}{4}$ " (kites).

Panel:

Cut out each month. Fold each block in half twice to find the center. Finger press on the fold and trim down to 8 $\frac{1}{4}$ " square.

Cut out the Share your umbrella... and We can share... blocks along the dashed lines. Separate by cutting along the middle of the stripes that separate both blocks. Fold each block in half twice to find the center. Finger press and unfold. Trim down to an 8 $\frac{1}{4}$ " square.

Ribbon: cut each piece of ribbon into 4 equal pieces.

Once the ribbon is attached you can adjust the length to your preference.

SEWING:

Quilt center

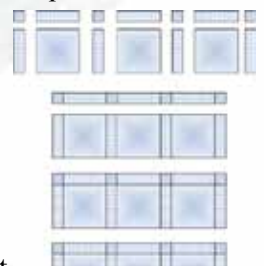
1. Follow the diagram and lay out the month blocks, Red brick sashing strips, and stripe corner squares.

2. Sew the sashing strips, and corner squares into rows. Sew the blocks and the sashing strips into rows. Press the seam towards the sashing pieces

3. Sew the rows together. Press the seam towards the sashing pieces.

4. Press the quilt center. Square the corners if necessary. The quilt center should measure 31 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 41 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

5. The top and bottom border strip sets include a block in the center of the strip. To make these strips sets, sew one 4" x 22" Blue Fireworks strip to one side of a 4" x 22" Red Multi-Print strip, press the seam towards the blue strip. Now sew a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" Green Veggies strip to the other of the Red Multi-Print strip, press the seam towards the red strip. Repeat these steps with the remaining 4" x 22" Blue Fireworks, 4" x 22" Red Multi-Print and the 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" Green Veggies strips. You will have 4 strip sets.



6. Sew a 1 7/8" x 8 1/4" Blue Fireworks strip to the top of the We can share... block and a 1 7/8" x 8 1/4" Blue Fireworks strip to the bottom of the Share your umbrella... block. Press the seams away from the block.

7. Sew a 22" long border strip set to the left side of the We can share... block, the Blue Fireworks strip should be at the top. Sew a 22" long border strip set to the right side of the We can share... block, again the Blue Fireworks strip should be at the top of the block. Repeat with the remaining 22" long border strip sets and the Share your umbrella... block. The Blue Fireworks strips should be at the bottom of the block. Press the seams towards the block. You will have two strip sets, one for the top and one the bottom.

8. For the side border strip sets, sew one 4" x 60" Blue Fireworks strip to one side of a 4" x 60" Red Multi-Print strip; press the seam towards the blue strip. Now sew a 2 1/2" x 60" Green Veggies strip to the other of the Red Multi-Print strip, press the seam towards the red strip. Repeat these steps with the remaining 4" x 60" Blue Fireworks, 4" x 60" Red Multi-Print and the 2 1/2" x 60" Green Veggies strips. You will have 2 strip sets.

9. Find the center of the sides and the top and bottom of the quilt top center and mark this spot. Fold the border strip sets in half and mark the center of the strip sets. Match the center of one of the 60" long strips to the side center mark of the quilt top center. Refer to the picture for color placement. Pin the border to the quilt top center. Repeat with the other 60" long strip. All the strips are longer than necessary to allow for the mitering of the corners.

10. Beginning 1/4" from the edge of the quilt top center and ending 1/4" from the edge of the quilt top center sew the side border in place. Press towards the border strip sets.

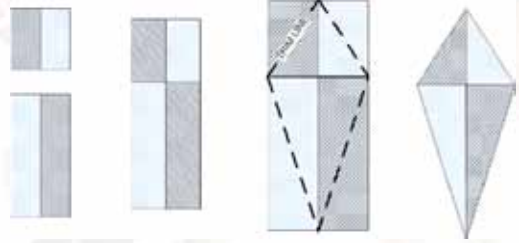
11. In the same way, sew the block and border strip sets to the top and bottom of the quilt top center.

12. Miter the corners.

Kites

13. Sew one red 4" x 5 3/4" rectangle to one stripe 4" x 5 3/4" rectangle along the 5 3/4" side. Press towards the red. The pieced rectangle should measure 7 1/2" x 5 3/4".

14. Sew one red 4" x 11 1/4" rectangle to one stripe 4" x 11 1/4" rectangle along the 11 1/4" side. Press towards the red. The pieced rectangle should measure 7 1/2" x 11 1/4"



15. Make a four-patch block by placing the sewn rectangle sets, one on top of the other, right sides together (RST) as shown below. Matching the center seam and the edges, sew the rectangles together along the 7 1/2" side. The four-patch should measure 7 1/2" x 16 1/2" finished.

16. Follow the manufacturer's directions and fuse the webbing material to the back of the four-patch.

17. Draw a line from the side edges of the four-patch, at the seam, to the top or bottom of the four-patch, also at the seam. Using the rotary cutter, cut along the trim line.

18. Repeat to make a total of four kites.

19. Place the kites, at an angle, on each corner of the quilt.

20. Place one piece of ribbon of each color under the bottom point of the kite. Secure the ribbons with a small hand or machine stitch.

21. Follow the manufacturer's directions and fuse the kites to the quilt top.

FINISH THE QUILT

22. Cut the backing fabric into 2 pieces, 58 1/2" yards long.

23. Using a 1/4" - 1/2" seam allowance, sew the two pieces of backing fabric together, along the long side. Press the seam open.

24. Center and lay the batting on top of the wrong side of the backing fabric

25. Center and lay the pieced quilt top on top of the batting.

26. Pin or baste the quilt sandwich using your preferred method for securing the layers.

27. Quilt as desired.

28. Use the 2 1/4" wide blue strip to bind the quilt.

Remember to keep in mind the directionality of the fabrics when creating the quilt layout!
