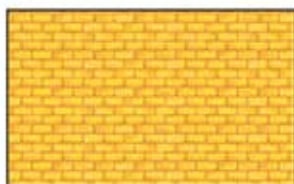

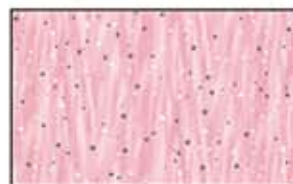

Cutting

20430-B Wizard of Oz Scenic

For blocks:

33 - 4 1/2" squares, capturing different scenes

For border:

8 strips at 4 1/2"

25650-P Glinda Dress Allover

12 - 4 1/2" squares, and 3 strips at 2 1/2"

20422-B Gingham

1 strip at 2 1/2"

6 - 4 7/8" squares, cut in half diagonally

20429-S Yellow Brick Road

16 - 4 7/8" squares, cut in half diagonally

2 - 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" cut along width

2 - 4 1/2" x 12 1/2", cut along length

8 strips at 2" for inner border

25651-B Dorothy Allover

32 - 4 1/2" squares, centering Dorothy image

20427-S Ruby Slippers

10 - 4 7/8" squares, cut in half diagonally

20426-R Glinda Wands

2 strips at 2 1/2"

7 strips at 2 1/2" for binding

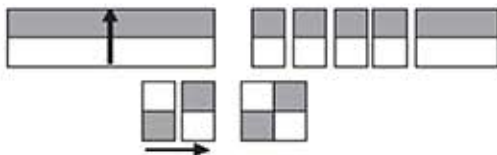
Use standard 1/4" seam allowance throughout.

Sewing the Blocks

4-Patches

Make eight Pink & Gingham 4-patches as follows:

1. With right sides together, sew a 2 1/2" Glinda Dress strip to a 2 1/2" Gingham strip. Press toward darker fabric.
2. Crosscut the strip set into 16 sections, each 2 1/2".
3. Sew two sections together, flipping one over so dark and light are opposite. Seams should butt at the center. Press. Repeat to make eight units.



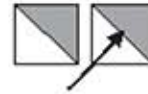
Make sixteen Pink & Red Wand 4-patches as follows:

1. With right sides together, sew a 2 1/2" Glinda Dress strip to a 2 1/2" Glinda Wand strip. Repeat with a second set of strips. Press toward darker fabric.
2. Crosscut the strip sets into 32 sections, each 2 1/2".
3. Sew two sections together as above. Press. Repeat to make sixteen units.

Half-Square Triangles

Make twelve Yellow Brick Road and Blue Gingham half-square triangles by sewing twelve each of the diagonally cut 4 7/8" triangles right sides together; sew and press toward the darker fabric.

Make twenty Yellow Brick Road and Ruby Slipper half-square triangles by placing twenty each of the diagonally cut 4 7/8" triangles right sides together; sew and pressing toward the darker fabric.



Sewing the Quilt Top

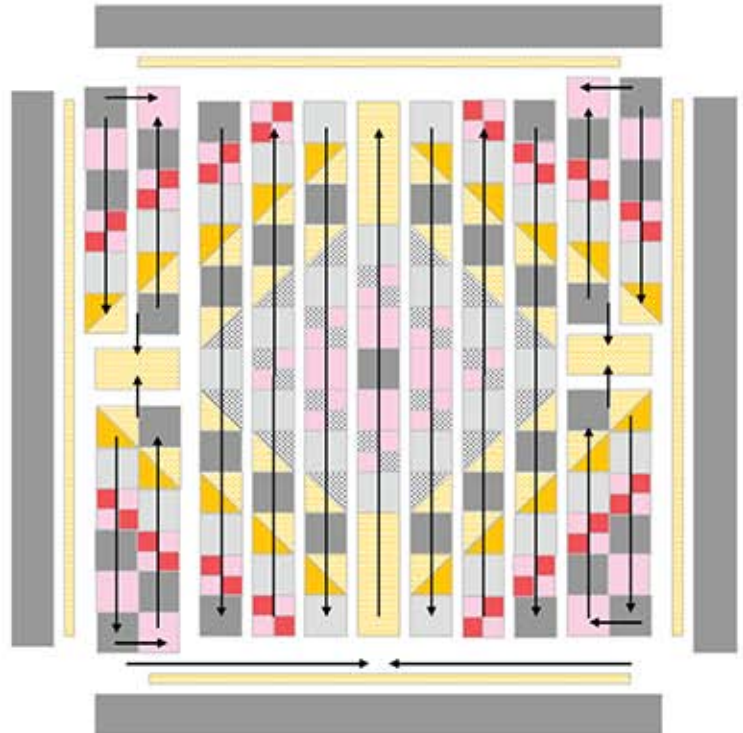
Lay out all squares, 4-patches and half-square triangles as shown in the color photo and diagram below. The quilt top is sewn in vertical rows. For the first two rows on the left and the last two on the right, sew the top of the rows together, and the bottom of the rows together, then sew these sections to the 8 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle of Yellow Brick Road fabric.

Press seams of each row in opposite directions, starting with pressing the first row toward the bottom of the quilt. Arrows indicate pressing directions.

Sew rows together. Be sure to pin at EACH seam intersection when sewing rows together. Press all rows toward the center of the quilt.

Sashings & Borders

1. Sew the 2" Yellow Brick Road strips into four sets of two strips each for the inner border. Sew to the sides, press toward the border, trim as necessary. Repeat for the top and bottom.
2. Sew the 4 1/2" Scenic strips into four sets of two strips each for the outer border. Sew to the sides, press toward the border, trim as necessary. Repeat for the top and bottom.
3. Layer, quilt and bind.
