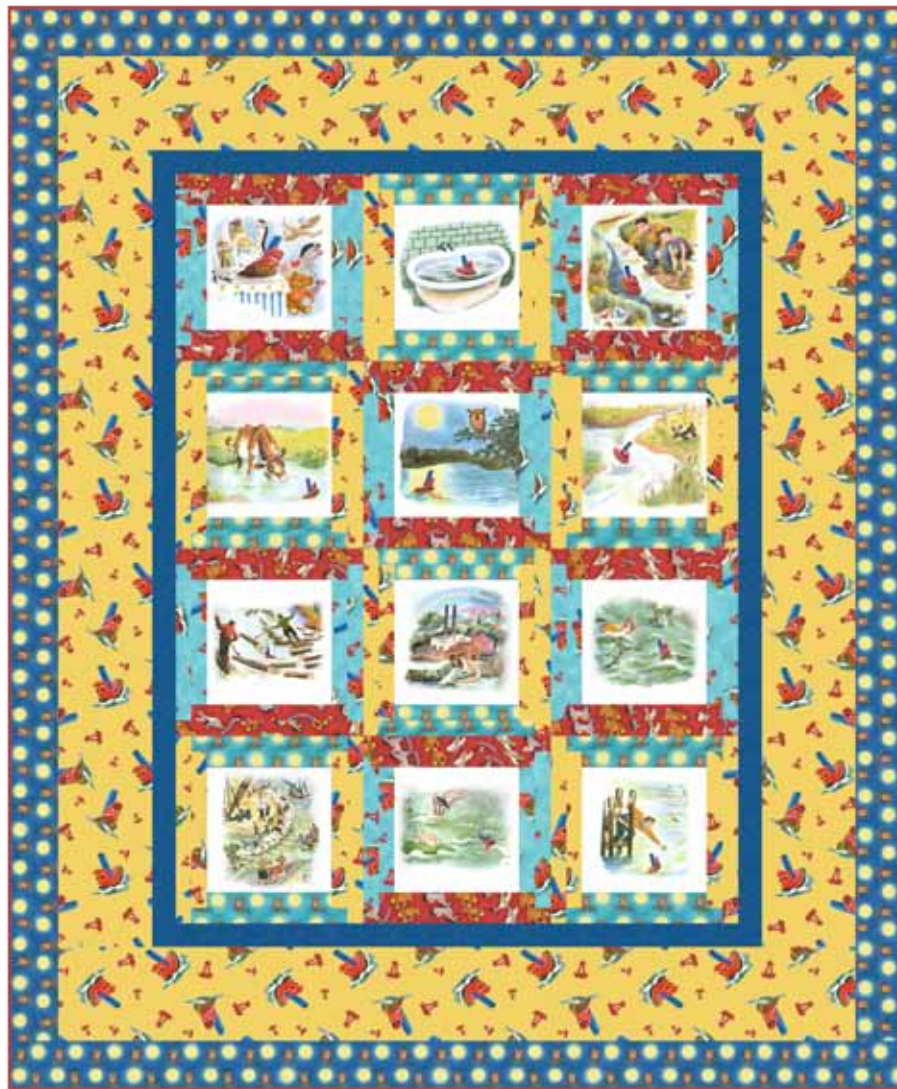


# Scuffy the Tugboat

## Cutting

*(Unless otherwise noted, all strips are cut across the width of the fabric from selvage edge to selvage edge.)*

### From the printed panel, cut:

(12) 8 1/2" x 8 1/2" squares with a printed "page" motif centered in each cut square and noting the page number of each printed scene.

### From EACH of the light blue owls and blue tugboats, cut:

Cut (7) 1 1/2" strips. Sub cut into (12) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" and (12) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" pieces.

### From the yellow tugboats, cut:

Cut (6) 6 1/2" strips for the middle border.

Cut (8) 1 1/2" strips. Sub cut into (12) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" and (12) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" pieces.

### From the red toys, cut:

Cut (8) 1 1/2" strips. Sub cut into (12) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" and (12) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" pieces.

### From the dark blue owls, cut:

Cut (7) 3 1/2" strips for the outer border.

### From the navy dot, cut:

Cut (5) 2" strips for the inner border.

### From the red dot, cut:

Cut (7) 2 1/4" strips for the binding.

## Sewing

*(All seams are sewn with right sides together, raw edges even and using 1/4" seam allowance. Press after each seam)*

### Make the Blocks from the Odd-Numbered Pages

*Note: Strips are added to the sides first, then the top and bottom.*

1. Stitch 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" blue tugboats pieces to the left and right sides of each trimmed odd-numbered "page" square (numbers 1, 3, 5, 7, 9 & 11). Sew 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" red toys pieces to the top and bottom of each square.

2. Stitch 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" blue tugboats pieces to the left and right sides of each square from step 1. Sew 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" red toys pieces to the top and bottom of each square to yield (6) complete blocks.



### Make the Blocks from the Even-Numbered Pages

*Note: Strips are added to the top and bottom first, then the sides.*

3. Stitch 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" light blue owls pieces to the top and bottom of each trimmed even-numbered "page" square (numbers 2, 4, 6, 8, 10 & 12). Sew 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" yellow tugboat pieces to the left and right sides of each square.

4. Stitch 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" light blue owls pieces to the top and bottom of each square from step 3. Sew 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" yellow tugboat pieces to the left and right sides of each square to yield (6) complete blocks.



## Quilt Assembly

5. Arrange the odd and even-numbered page blocks into (4) rows with (3) blocks in each row, keeping the "pages" in numerical order as shown in the placement diagram to the right. Stitch the blocks into rows and sew the rows together to complete the quilt center.

6. Trim two 2" Navy strips at a 39 1/2" length. Join the three remaining 2 navy dot strips together end to end, using diagonal seams, from this long strip, cut (2) 48 1/2" lengths *(if your measurements are different, cut to fit your quilt top)*. Stitch the longer lengths to the left and right sides of the quilt top. Sew the shorter lengths to the top and bottom.

7. Join the 6 1/2" yellow tugboats strips together end to end, using diagonal seams, and from this long strip, cut (4) 51 1/2" lengths *(if your measurements are different, cut to fit your quilt top)*. Stitch (2) lengths to the left and right sides of the quilt top. Sew (2) lengths to the top and bottom.

8. Join the the 3 1/2" dark blue owls strips together end to end using diagonal seams, from this long strip, cut (2) 63 1/2" and (2) 57 1/2" lengths *(if your measurements are different, cut to fit your quilt top)*. Stitch the longer lengths to the left and right sides of the quiltpop. Sew the shorter lengths to the top and bottom.

9. Layer the completed quilt top with batting and backing and quilt as desired. Join the 2 1/4" red dot strips together and bind the finished quilt .
