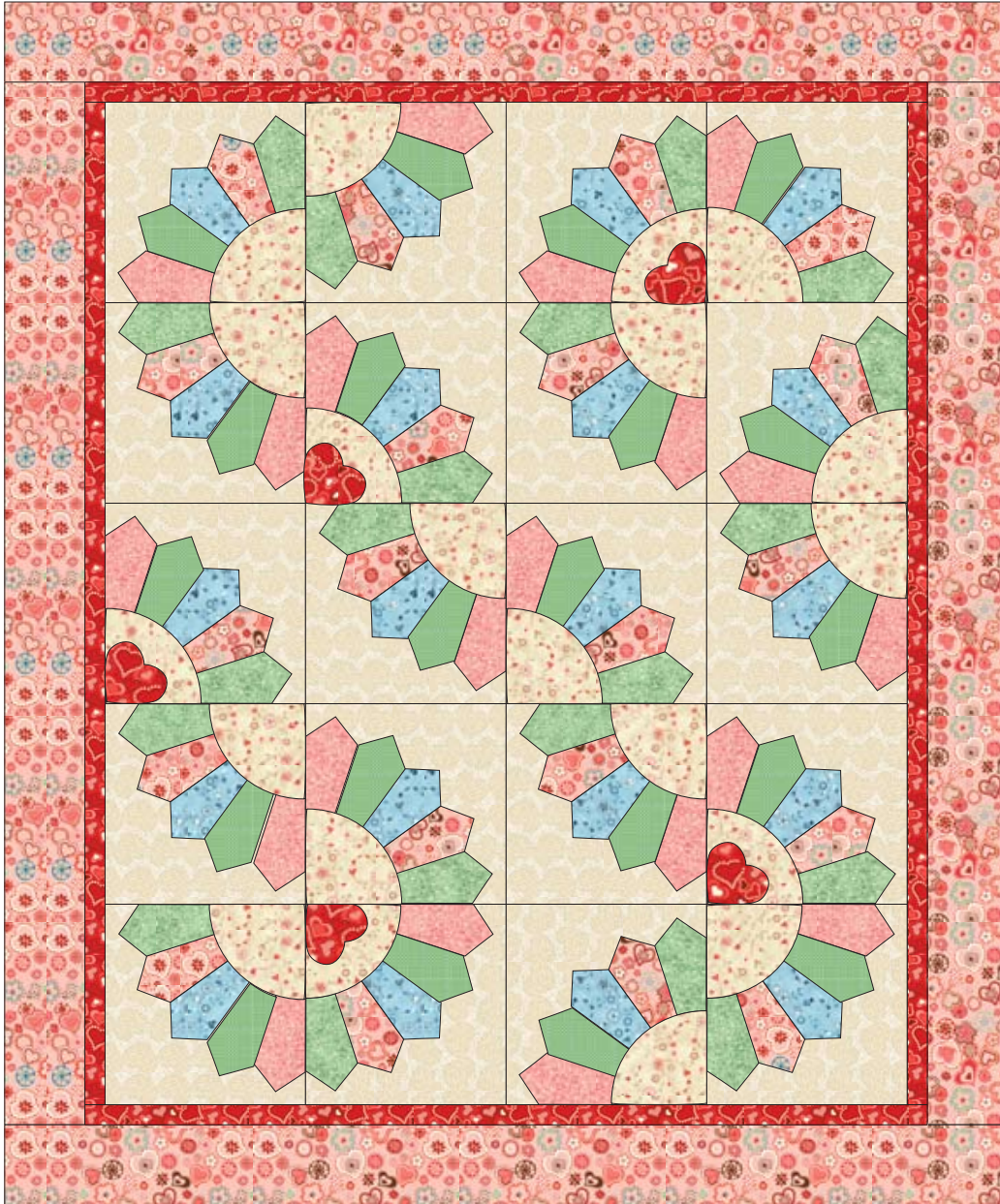

Cutting

Cream background print - 20366-E

(20) 10-1/2" squares

Green check - 20370-H

(20) fan blades using pattern

Pink multi-print - 20364-C

(20) fan blades using pattern

(2) 4-1/2" x 52-1/2" vertical border strips

(2) 4-1/2" x 50-1/2" horizontal border strips

(6) 2-1/4" x 42" binding strips

Red heart print - 20365-R

(10) hearts for pockets using pattern

(2) 1-1/2" x 50-1/2" vertical border strips

(2) 1-1/2" x 42-1/2" horizontal border strips

Blue print - 20371-B

(20) fan blades using pattern

Green vine print - 20369-G

(20) fan blades using pattern

Pink vine print - 20369-C

(20) fan blades using pattern

Cream with red print - 20371-E

(1) 64" x 42" backing piece

(2) 12" x 32-1/2" backing pieces

(20) fan base quarter circles using pattern

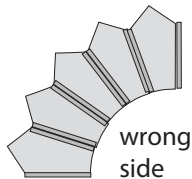
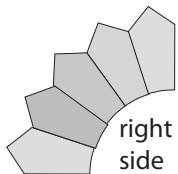

Sewing

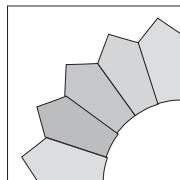
Use standard 1/4" seam allowance throughout.

Use fabric basting spray to hold fan blades and quarter circle in place for machine applique.

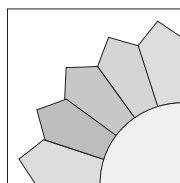
1. Sew 5 fan blades (1 of each print) into a quarter circle. Press open the seams that join the fan blades.



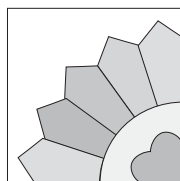
2. Spray baste a fan blade assembly on a cream background square aligning the outside edges on each end to the sides of the background square. Applique in place along the top pointed edge only. Use a buttonhole stitch and cream thread.



3. Spray baste the cream with red print quarter round in the corner and applique in place using a buttonhole stitch and cream thread along the curved edge of the quarter round fan base. Make 20 blocks.



4. Heart Pockets - Using the 10 hearts, make 5 sets with right sides together. Sew each set together along the top side of the hearts. Turn right sides out. Position the hearts in the corner of five of the fan blocks.



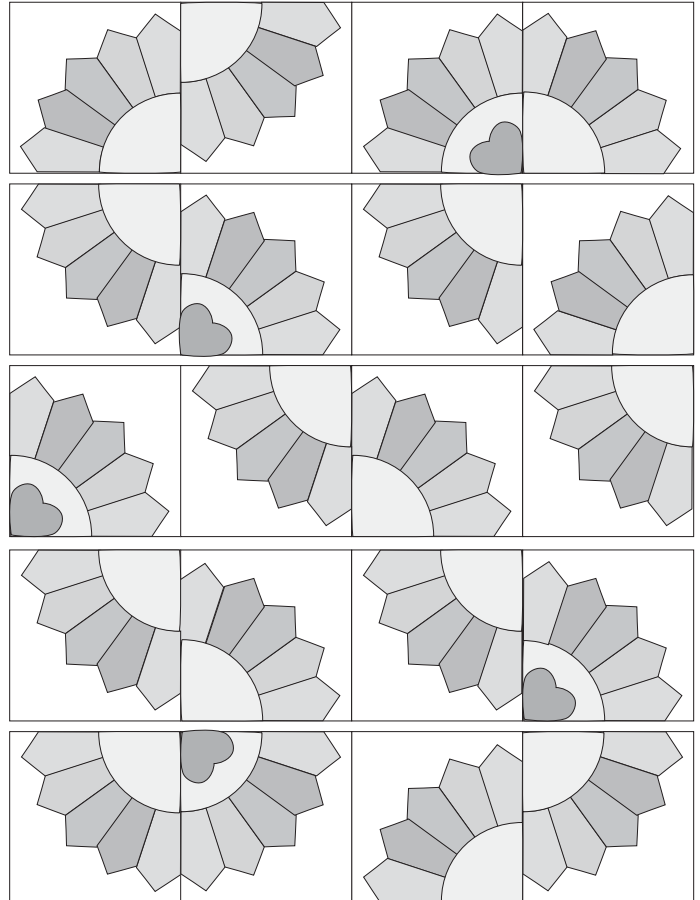
Quilt Assembly

5. Sew the blocks together in 5 rows of 4 blocks each.

Carefully position the direction of the fans and the 5

blocks with the heart pockets as shown in the diagram.

Sew down the sides of the hearts as you sew the block together, leaving the applique tops open to make pockets.



Borders

6. Sew the vertical red heart print borders to opposite sides of the quilt top. Sew the horizontal red heart print borders to top and bottom of the quilt top.

7. Sew the vertical pink multi-print borders to opposite sides of the quilt top. Sew the horizontal pink multi-print borders to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

Finishing

8. Sew the two small cream with red print backing pieces together along the short sides and press the seams open. Sew this piece to the large backing piece to make the quilt backing. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top and baste the layers together. Quilt along the seam lines of the fan blades and in a meandering pattern on the background fabrics. Do not quilt the red hearts.
9. Sew the binding strips into one long strip. Fold in half and press fold line. With raw edges of binding even with raw edges of quilt top, sew to the quilt top. Turn the folded edge to the back and stitch in place.
