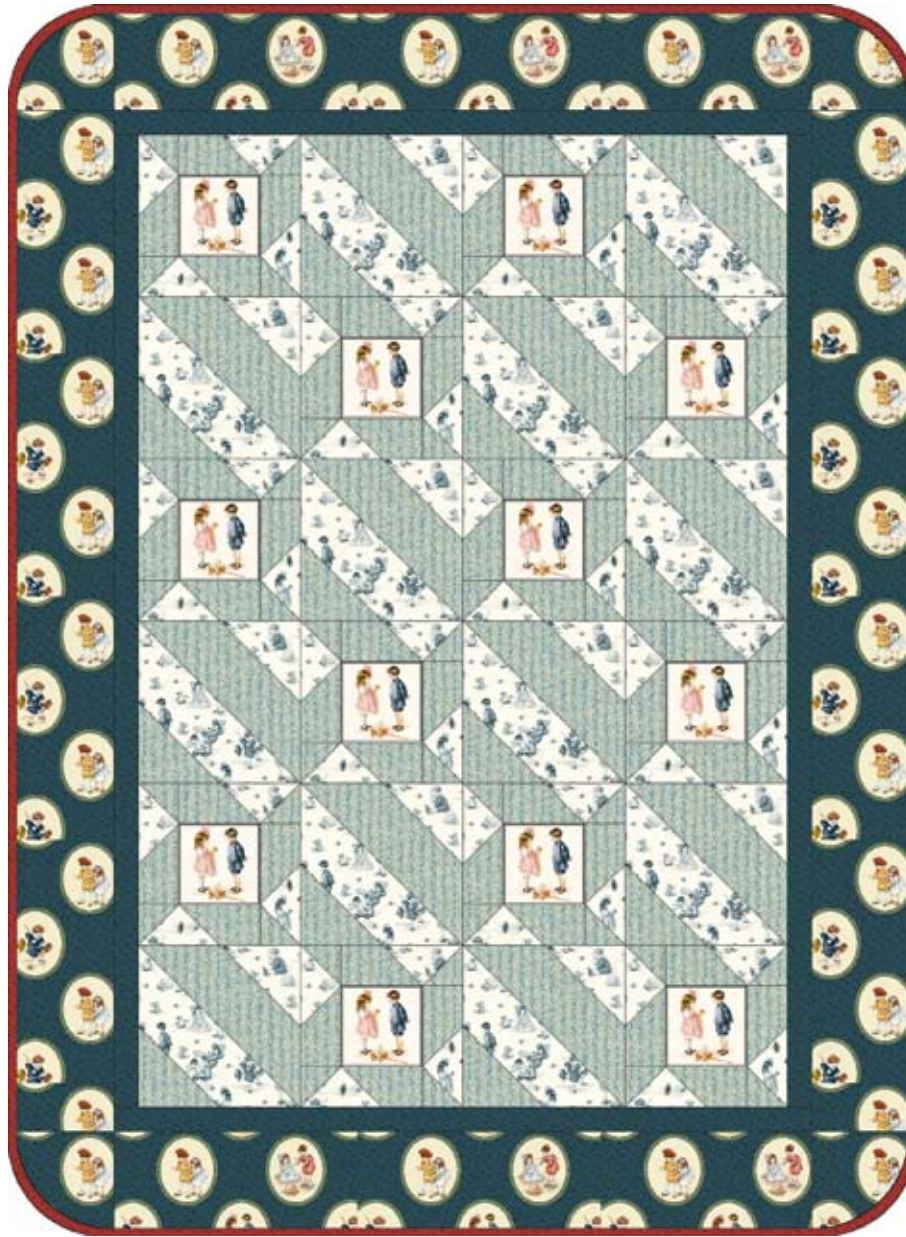

CUTTING:

#20435-B, Blue Stripe (Blocks)

- Cut (2) 10 7/8" x WOF (width of fabric)
- Subcut (6) 10 7/8" x 10 7/8" squares
- Cut (2) 5 1/2" x WOF, Subcut (12) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" squares
- Cut (2) 3 3/8" x WOF, Subcut (24) 3 3/8" x 3 3/8" squares
- Cut (8) 3" x WOF, Subcut (48) 3" x 5 1/2" rectangles

#20438-B, Blue Children (Blocks)

- Cut (2) 10 7/8" x WOF, Subcut (6) 10 7/8" x 10 7/8" squares
- Cut (2) 5 1/2" x WOF, Subcut (12) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" squares
- Cut (2) 3 3/8" x WOF, Subcut (24) 3 3/8" x 3 3/8" squares
- Cut (4) 3" x WOF, Subcut (48) 3" x 3" squares

#20431-E, Cream Blocks (Blocks)

Fussy Cut (12) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" squares; using the dark brown line around the image as the guideline, cut 1/4" from this line around all 4 sides.

#20437-N, Blue Tone on Tone (Inner Border)

- Cut (7) 2" x WOF

#20433-N, Blue Oval Picture Frame (Outer Border)

- Cut (2) 6 1/2" x length of fabric (follow selvage edge)
- Cut (4) 6 1/2" x WOF (fabric left after above cut)
- ***Center images within the 6 1/2" width.

#20437-M, Red Tone on Tone (Binding)

- Cut (7) 2 1/2" x WOF

SEWING: Block A

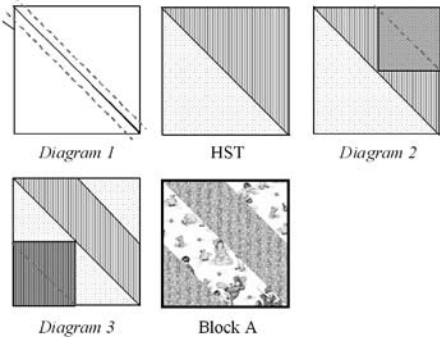
Iron the print and stripe 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" squares, in half, on the diagonal with wrong sides together. Set aside.

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the (6) print 10 7/8" x 10 7/8" squares. Layer the (6) print and stripe 10 7/8" x 10 7/8" squares, right sides together, sew a 1/4" seam on each side of the drawn line.

Diagram 1. Cut unit apart on the drawn line, yielding (12) 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" half square triangle (HST). Press seam towards the stripe fabric.

Lay the print 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" square on top of the HST, right sides together, stripe fabric corner. *Diagram 2.* The fold line will be your sew line. Sew corner to corner. Cut away extra fabric. Repeat with opposite corner using the print 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" squares. *Diagram 3.* Make (12)

Block A

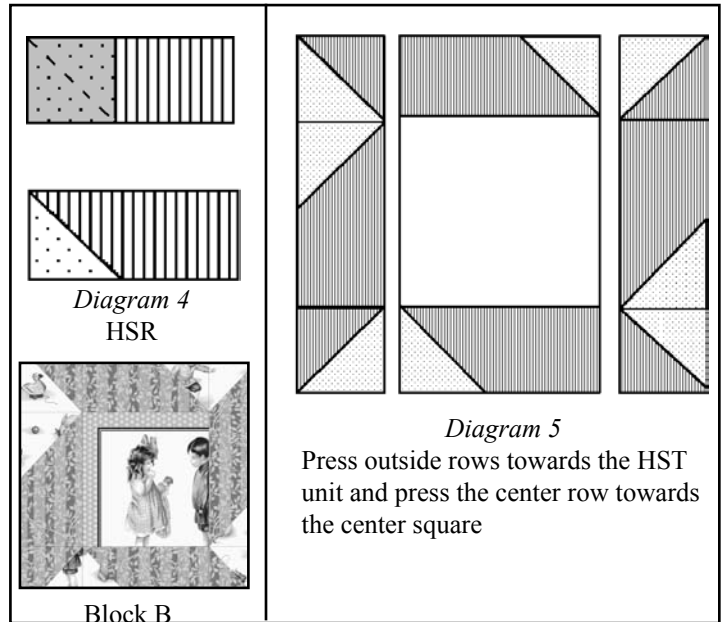


Sewing: Block B

Make (48) HST units using the print and stripe 3 3/8" x 3 3/8" squares. Follow the same method as above. Press towards stripe fabric.

Press the print 3" x 3" squares in half, on the diagonal with wrong sides together. With right sides together, lay the 3" x 3" square on top of the left side of the stripe 3" x 5 1/2" rectangle. Sew on the fold line. Cut away extra fabric. Press towards the print fabric. *Diagram 4.* Make (48) half triangle rectangles (HSR).

Using *Diagram 5* make (6) Block B

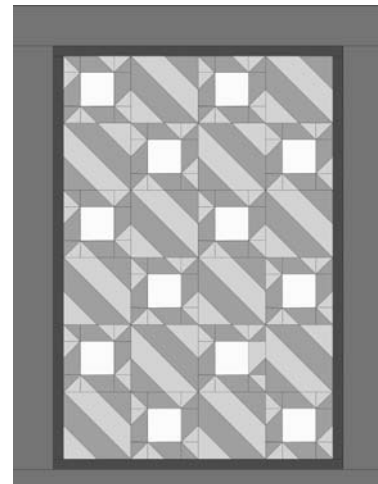


QUILT ASSEMBLY: Use the layout below to assemble the quilt blocks.

Inside Border: Miter the short ends of the (8) 2" x WOF together making one long strip. Cut (2) 2" x 60 1/2" and sew these to the sides of the quilt top. Cut (2) 2" x 43 1/2" and sew these to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

Outer Border: Cut (2) 6 1/2" x 63 1/2" from the long selvage edge cuts. Sew these to the sides of the quilt. Sew short ends of (2) 6 1/2" x WOF together making one long strip. Try to match print. Repeat. Trim both to 6 1/2" x 55 1/2" and sew these to the top and bottom of the quilt.

Finish: Finish the quilt with your favorite form of machine quilting. Curved corners are a great finishing touch, just use a dinner plate to draw a curve onto each corner. Cut on the drawn line and bind with favorite method. Don't forget to stand back and admire your work.
