



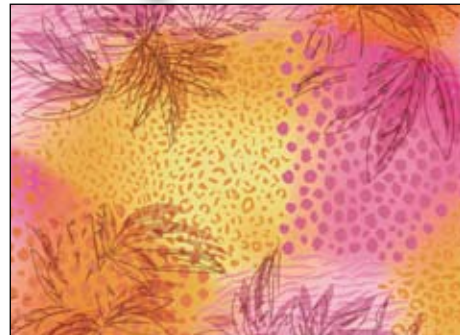
# Flintstones Jewelry Pouch



# and Cosmetic Brush Roll



25667-P 7/8 yard  
(1/2 yard for Pouch, 3/8 yard for Brush Roll)



25666-SP 1 yard  
(1/2 yard for Pouch, 1/2 yard for Brush Roll)

## Jewelry Pouch

½ yard main fabric 25667-P

½ yard coordinating fabric 25666-SP

Matching thread

Optional: 1 yard of ribbon or cord for ties

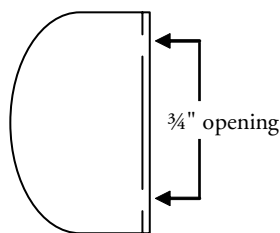
Cut one 10½" diameter circle from main fabric

Cut one 10" diameter circle from coordinating fabric

Cut two 7" diameter circles from coordinating fabric

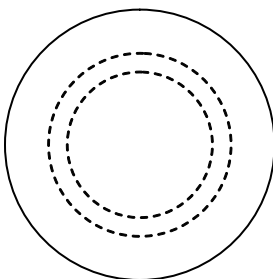
Cut one 1½" x 44" strip from coordinating fabric (tie, cut width of fabric)

Cut 10½" circle in half. Place halves right sides together and stitch seam using ¼" seam allowance, leaving ¾" opening located 1" from beginning and end of seam as indicated in illustration A. Press seam open. Carefully stitch down seam allowances at openings to secure.

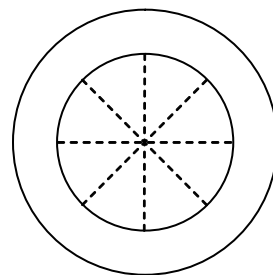
Place lining circle and seamed circle right sides together and stitch together using ¼" seam, leaving 2" opening for turning. Turn right side out and slip stitch opening closed, press. Carefully topstitch around outer edge of circle ¾" from edge and then again 1 ½" from edge creating casing for drawstring. See illustration B. Edge stitch circle.

### Lining

Place 7" circles right sides together. Stitch using ¼" seam allowance leaving 2" opening for turning. Turn, slip stitch opening shut, press. Edge stitch.

Center 7" circle over 10" circle, *be sure lining is face up*. Pin and carefully stitch through all thicknesses as shown in illustration C. *Be sure casing opening is left free.*

### Drawstring

Press short ends of tie in ¼" and press. Fold tie lengthwise in half and press. Fold long edges in again to center and press. Carefully stitch along edges of tie. Insert tie through casing.

## Cosmetic Brush Roll

¾ yard main fabric 25667-P

½ yard coordinating fabric 25666-SP

¼ yard iron on interfacing

Matching thread

Optional - 1 yard ½" satin or grosgrain ribbon for tie

Cut

1 Main fabric 9" x 12"

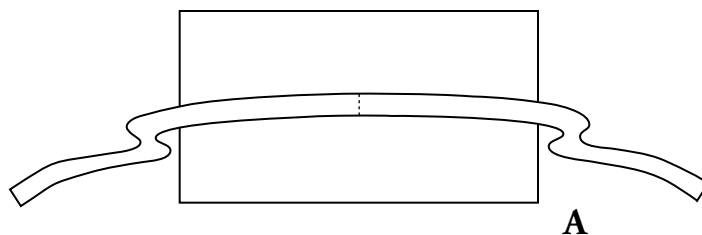
1 Coordinating fabric 9" x 12" (lining)

1 Coordinating fabric (pockets) 6" x 12"

1 strip Coordinating fabric 1 ½" x 36" (tie)

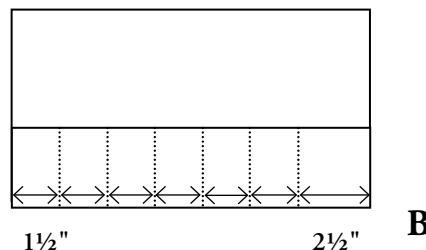
Iron-on interfacing 9" x 12"

Apply interfacing to wrong side of main rectangle according to manufacturer's directions. Press short ends of tie in ¼" and press. Fold tie lengthwise in half and press. Fold long edges in again to center and press. Carefully stitch along edges of tie. Center tie on right side of main fabric rectangle, stitch to secure.

Press under ¼" on top of pocket. Turn under 1" and stitch close to hem. Pin pocket over lining *right sides up*. Baste. Stitch as indicated in illustration B or at best measurement for your brushes.

Pin main rectangle and lining right sides together, keeping tie ends free. Stitch around all sides using ¼" seam allowance, leave 2" open for turning. Turn and press. Slipstitch opening closed. Top stitch the two layers together close to the tie. Edge stitch ¼" from the edge around brush roll.
