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Intermediate Quilting Skills

Quilt Designed by Vicki Niro

Finished Block Size: 7" x 7"

CUTTING:

Block Print - fussy cut (12) 5½" x 5½" square images of blue, yellow and pink edged blocks. **Blocks**

Green Hearts - Cut (2) 5½ x WOF (width of fabric)

Subcut (12) 5½" x 5½" squares. **Blocks**

Pink Floral, Blue with Hats, Yellow Candy Boxes,

Candy Strips*** – from all fabrics. **Blocks**

Cut (4) 2½ x WOF Subcut (24) 2½ x 5½"

Cut (1) 2⅞ x WOF

Subcut (12) 2⅞" x 2⅞" squares.

Pink with Chocolates - Cut (8) 2½ x WOF. **Inner**

Border

Cut (7) 2½" x WOF. **Binding**

TV Print – Cut (8) 6½" x WOF. **Outer Border**

Block Print – Cut (2) 2¼ yards pieces. **Backing**

Sew long selvage edge together. Remember, this is a directional fabric. Press seam open.

*** **Cut the Candy Strip fabric following the selvage edge.**

BLOCKS: This is an easy Attic Window Block, no mitered seams and you are only using one color of fabric instead of two. Separate your fabric squares into piles by color; match the 2⅞" x 2⅞" squares and the 2½" x 5½" rectangles with each colored square per quilt image.

Work with one colorway at a time.

Half Square Triangles (HST) – Draw a line from corner to corner on (6) 2⅞ x 2⅞" squares. Using the same fabric colors, place a square with a drawn line on top of a square without a drawn line. Sew ¼" on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. Press seam to one side. Make (12) HST units. *Diagram 1*

Sew 2½" x 5½" pieces to the bottom of a fussy cut 5½" x 5½" square. Make (12), Unit A. *Diagram 2* Press toward sq.

Sew a HST to one short end of a 2½" x 5½" piece. Make (12), Unit B. *Diagram 3* Press toward HST.

Sew Unit B to the left side of Unit A. Make (12). *Diagram 4* Press. Make 12 blocks of each colorway.

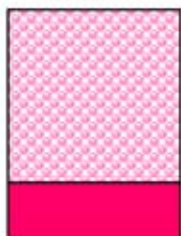

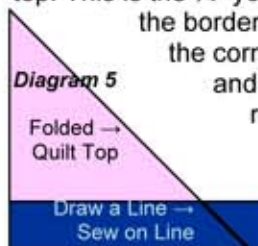

LAYOUT your blocks, using the above diagram. Sew blocks together to make a row. Press the even rows to the right and the odd rows to the left. Sew rows together to make the quilt top center.

MITERED INNER BORDER/OUTER BORDER: Miter the short ends of (2) 2½ x WOF, Pink with Chocolate strips. Repeat 3 more times. Use the same method for the TV Print, 6½ x WOF strips. Sew (1) long edge of the Inner Border strip to (1) long edge of the Outer Border strip. Repeat 3 more times. Find the center of each border unit and mark with a pin. Find the center of each edge of the quilt top center and mark with a pin.

Matching pins, pin a border unit to each edge of the quilt top center. Sew in place, start ¼" in from the top edge and stop a ¼" in from the bottom edge. Press the side seam towards the quilt center and the top and bottom seams towards the border. Fold the quilt top in half on the diagonal, interlock the border seams and pin in place. Draw a line extending the folded edge of the quilt top onto the border extension. Start sewing on the drawn line at the intersection of the border and the quilt top. This is the ¼" you did not sew when attaching the border unit. Open quilt top to make sure the corner is flat, trim excess fabric away and press seam open. Repeat with remaining 3 corners. *Diagram 5*
