Skill Level: Intermediate, knowledge of paper piecing helpful

Cutting Directions:

WOF= width of fabric

Panel blocks 21880 N (8 blocks)

Fussy cut the squares centering each image and extending into the navy area around the panels, cut blocks to 9 ½" X 9 ½" square. Finished blocks should have approximately ¼" of navy band around the panel blocks.

Cream Paddington Toile 21885 A - 1 yard

For the paper pieced blocks; cut the pieces slightly larger than the patches shown in paper-piecing block guide for seven blocks

Yellow street print 21886 S - ½ yard

Cut 1 strip @ 2 ¼" x WOF; sub cut 8 squares @ 2 ¼" x 2 ¼"

Use the remaining for the paper pieced blocks; cut the pieces slightly larger than the patches shown in paper-piecing block guide for two blocks

Red street print 21886 R - 1⅛ yard

Cut 1 strip @ 2 ¼" x WOF; sub cut 16 squares @ 2 ¼" x 2 ¼"

Cut 5 strips @ 1 ½" x WOF; sub cut two of the strips @ 1 ½" x 38 ½"; join the remaining three strips using diagonal seams and sub cut two strips @ 1 ½" x 58"

Cut 6 strips @ 2 ½" x WOF; join the strips using diagonal seams for the binding strip

Use the remaining for the paper pieced blocks; cut the pieces slightly larger than the patches shown in paper-piecing block guide for two blocks

Blue street print 21886 Y - ¾ yard

Cut 5 strips @ 1 ½" x WOF; sub cut two of the strips @ 1 ½" x 36 ½"; join the remaining three strips using diagonal seams and sub cut two strips @ 1 ½" x 56"

Use the remaining for the paper pieced blocks; cut the pieces slightly larger than the patches shown in paper-piecing block guide for three blocks

Stripe 20407 YS - ⅞ yard

Cut 10 strips @ 2 ¼" x WOF; sub cut 38 rectangles @ 2 ¼" x 9 ½"

Blue bear print 21882 B - 1 yard

Cut 6 strips @ 4 ¾" x WOF; join the strips using diagonal seams, sub cut 2 strips @ 4 ¾" x 47" and 2 strips @ 4 ¾" x 60"

Backing 21881 B - 3 yards

Cut 2 strips @ 54" x WOF; sew the 2 pieces of fabric with the right sides together along the selvedge, using a 1" seam. Trim the seam and press to one side.

Use ¼" seam allowance throughout, unless otherwise indicated. Sew pieces with right sides together, matching raw edges.

Blocks Assembly:

1. Print the paper piecing template on your printer. "Page scaling" should be set to "none". Print one copy for each block plus one more for practice or if you make a mistake. Tape "Unit A" together; trim the paper along the thin black line, on one half of the template for Unit A. Then line up this edge with the line on the other half of the template. Referring to block assembly diagram, identify the fabric pieces that go with each numbered patch. Use your favorite paper-piecing method to build each block section, sequentially following the numbers. Sew the pieced units together to complete each block. Make a total of three blue, two red and two yellow airplane blocks. Finished block size; 9 ½" X 9 ½" (includes seam allowance).



Quilt Center Assembly:

1. Referring to the images below for block placement, sew rows of airplane and panel blocks together, with striped fabric sashing pieces in between. Make a total of five rows.



2. Sew three striped sashing rectangles and four red street print $2\frac{1}{4}$ " squares together to make a pieced sashing row. Repeat to make a total of four rows with red squares, and two rows with yellow squares.



3. Referring to the quilt center diagram shown below, sew all the block rows and sashing rows together to complete quilt top.



Inner Border #1

1. Sew two $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 56" blue street print inner border strips to the long sides of the quilt center.

2. Sew remaining two $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $36\frac{1}{2}$ " blue street print inner border strips to the top & bottom of the quilt center.

Inner Border #2

1. Sew two $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 58" red street print inner border strips to the long sides of the quilt center.

2. Sew remaining two $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $38\frac{1}{2}$ " red street print inner border strips to the top & bottom of the quilt center.

Outer Border

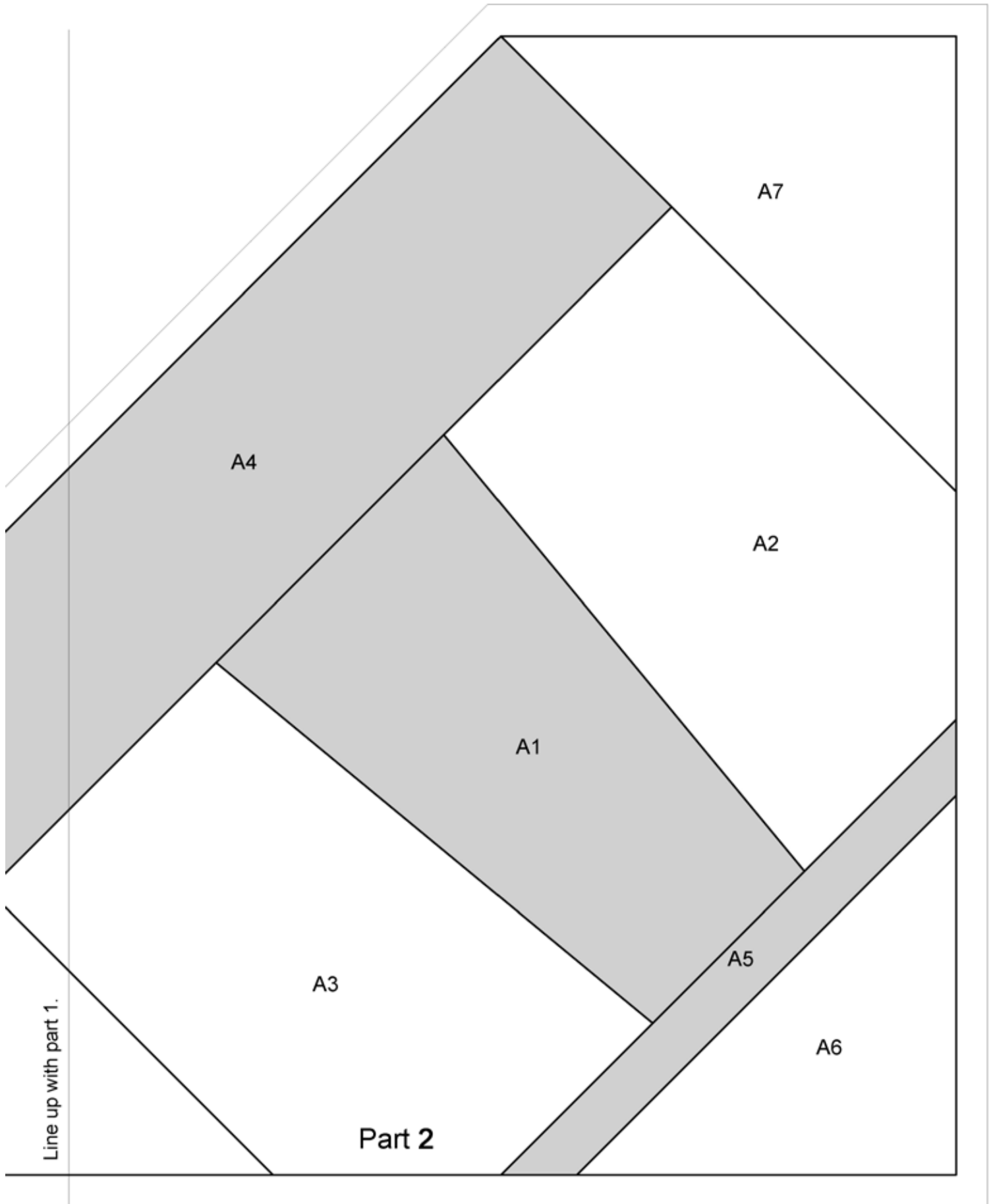
1. Sew two blue bear print $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x 60" border strips to the long sides of the quilt center.

2. Add the remaining two blue bear print $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x 47" strips to the remaining sides to the top & bottom of the quilt center to complete the quilt top.

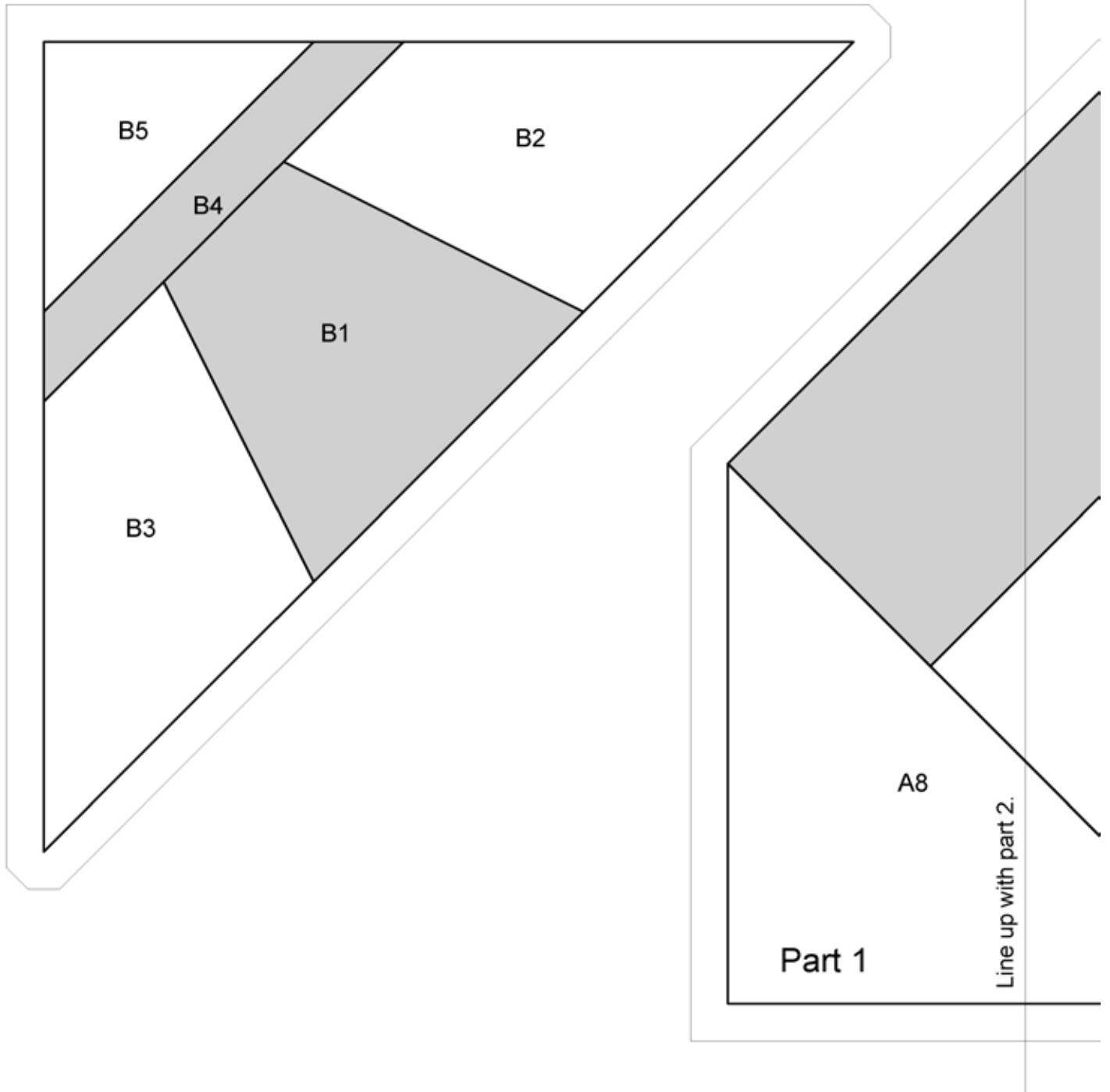
Finishing:

1. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing to make a quilt sandwich. Baste the layers together. Quilt as desired. Trim backing and batting so that they are even with the quilt top.

2. Bind with red street print binding strip.



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
