

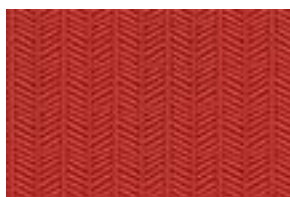

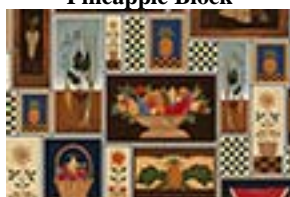

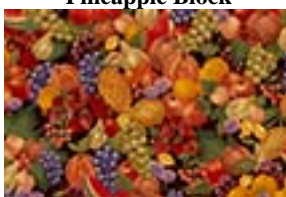

 Finished Quilt 65" x 82"
 Finished Block 12" x 12"

This quilt can be completed using two different methods, Paper Piecing or Foundation Piecing. If using the Paper Piecing Method you need to enlarge the PINEAPPLE BLOCK PATTERN, 161% and make (18) copies. If you choose the Foundation Pieced Method you will need 2 2/3 yards of muslin. Spray starch the muslin before you start the piecing method.

CUTTING: Pineapple Block;

20477-H, Green Weave

Cut (3) 6" x WOF (width of fabric), Subcut (18) 6" x 6" squares
 Cut on the diagonal once
 Cut (2) 7" x WOF, Subcut (36) 7" x 1 3/4"
 Cut (2) 6" x WOF, Subcut (36) 6" x 1 3/4"

20477-R, Red Weave

Cut (3) 6" x WOF, Subcut (18) 6" x 6" squares
 Cut on the diagonal once
 Cut (2) 7" x WOF, Subcut (36) 7" x 1 3/4"
 Cut (2) 6" x WOF, Subcut (36) 6" x 1 3/4"

20478-E, Ivory Flower

Cut (4) 7" x WOF, Subcut (72) 7" x 1 3/4"
 Cut (4) 6" x WOF, Subcut (72) 6" x 1 3/4"
 Cut (4) 5" x WOF, Subcut (72) 5" x 1 3/4"

20473-A, Fruit Clusters

Cut (3) 5" x WOF, Subcut (18) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" squares OR
 Fussy cut (18) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" squares "on point"

Setting/Corner Triangles:

20472-RS, All Over Fruit

Cut (1) 10" x WOF, Subcut (2) 10" x 10" squares
 Cut on the diagonal once (Corner ▲)
 Cut (2) 18 1/4" x WOF, Subcut (3) 18 1/4" x 18 1/4" squares
 Cut on the diagonal twice (Setting ▲)

Inner Border and Binding:

20476-ST, Checkerboard

Cut (7) 2" x WOF (Border)
 Cut (8) 2 1/2" x WOF (Binding)

Outer Border:

20473-A, Fruit Clusters

Cut (8) 5 1/2" x WOF

Muslin:

Cut (6) 13" x WOF, Subcut (18) 13" x 13" squares

SEWING: Paper Piecing Method

Enlarge the PINEAPPLE BLOCK PATTERN, 161% and make (18) copies. Using your favorite paper piecing method, make (18) blocks. Follow *IMAGE 1* for fabric placement. Square block up, 12 1/2" x 12 1/2".

Fabric Round 1 – Flower (4) 1 3/4" x 5"
 Fabric Round 2 – Red (2) 1 3/4" x 6" and Green (2) 1 3/4" x 6"
 Fabric Round 3 – Flower (4) 1 3/4" x 6"
 Fabric Round 4 – Red (2) 1 3/4" x 7" and Green (2) 1 3/4" x 7"
 Fabric Round 5 – Flower (4) 1 3/4" x 7"
 Fabric Round 6 – Red (2) ▲'s and Green (2) ▲'s

SEWING: Foundation Piecing Method

Iron the 13" x 13" Muslin squares in half, both directions. Repeat with the 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" Fruit Cluster squares. Place the 5 1/2" square on top of the 13" square, use the pressed lines for centering, *IMAGE 2*. Sew Round 1 fabric on per *IMAGE 3*. Start with Green Fabric from Round 2, follow *IMAGE 4*. Your Fussy Cut 5 1/2" square should be visually correct.

Trim away Round 1 extra fabric →

Sew 1/4" seam from this edge →

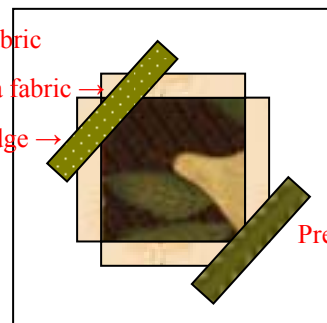
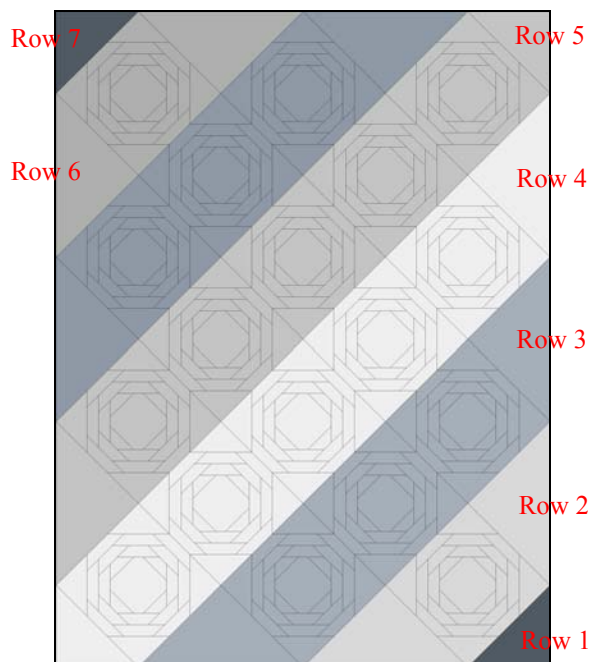

Continue sewing the fabric Rounds on until the block looks like *IMAGE 1*. Square block up, 12 1/2" x 12 1/2".

QUILT ASSEMBLY:

Rows are assembled diagonally. Press Even Rows to the RIGHT and Odd Rows to the LEFT. When sewing Rows together, nestle the block seams.



Inside Border: Miter the short ends of the (8) 2" x WOF together making one long strip. Cut (2) 2" x 71 1/2" and sew these to the sides of the quilt top. Cut (2) 2" x 54 1/2" and sew these to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

Outer Border: Miter the short ends of the (8) 5 1/2" x WOF together making one long strip. Cut (2) 5 1/2" x 81 1/2" and sew these to the sides of the quilt. Cut (2) 5 1/2" x 64 1/2" and sew these to the top and bottom of the quilt.

Layer: and finish quilt with your favorite method.
