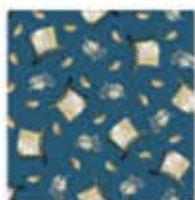

Finished Block Size - 9" x 9"

20897-J Cards (block)

Cut (1) 4" x WOF (width of fabric)

Subcut (4) 3½" x 3½" squares

Cut (1) 3⅞" x WOF Subcut (8) 3⅞" x 3⅞"

20898-B Blue Hats (block)

Cut (2) 3½" x WOF Subcut (16) 3½" x 3½" squares

Cut (1) 3⅞" x WOF Subcut (8) 3⅞" x 3⅞"

20898-T Red Hats (row, binding)

Cut (8) 2½" x WOF Subcut (2) 2½" x 36½"

Miter short ends of remaining (6) strips, press seam open. Press strip in half, wrong sides together, lengthwise. **BINDING**

20893-E Border Stripe (row)

Cut (2) 10¼" x WOF** Subcut (2) 10¼" x 36½"

** Make both images the same.

20894-E Character Writing (row)

Cut (4) 4" x WOF Subcut (4) 4" x 36½"

20895-G Card People (inner/outer border)

Cut (4) 2" x WOF Miter shorts ends.

Subcut (1) 2" x 53" **TOP** and (1) 2" x 63" **SIDE**

Cut (4) 5½" x WOF Miter short ends.

Subcut (1) 5½" x 72" **SIDE** and (1) 5½" x 53" **BOTTOM**

20896-B Alice Toss (inner/outer border)

Cut (4) 2" x WOF Miter shorts ends.

Subcut (1) 2" x 53" **TOP** and (1) 2" x 63" **SIDE**

Cut (4) 5½" x WOF Miter short ends.

Subcut (1) 5½" x 72" **SIDE** and (1) 5½" x 53" **BOTTOM**

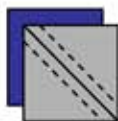
20892-B Blue Scenic (directional backing)

Cut (2) 2 yard cuts. Sew one long selvage edge together with a 1" wide seam allowance. Trim seam to ½" making sure to remove all of the selvage. Press seam open. **BACKING**

Press all seams towards the dark fabric unless otherwise stated.

Block Assembly:

Draw a line corner to corner on the (8) Cards 3⅞" x 3⅞" squares. Place the 3⅞" x 3⅞" Cards squares and the 3⅞" x 3⅞" Blue Hats squares right sides together. Sew a ¼" seam on each side of the drawn line. Cut the unit apart on the drawn line. (2) Half Square Triangle Units (HST)

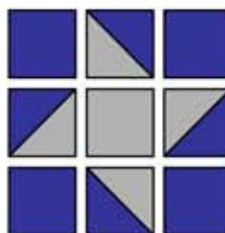

Assemble (4) Friendship Star Blocks per **Diagram 1** using the HST units and the 3½" x 3½" squares of the Cards and Blue Hats fabric.

Quilt Center Assembly:

Following **Diagram 2** to assemble the Quilt Center.

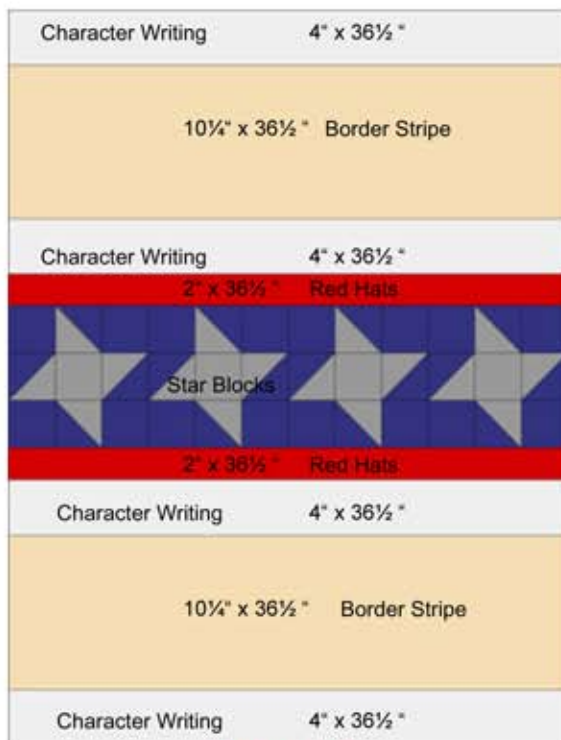

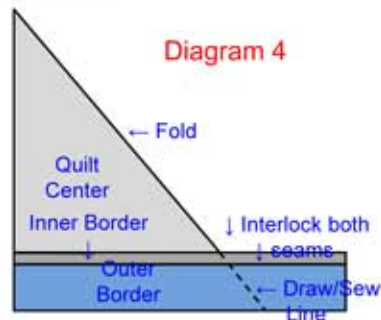

Mitered Borders:

Working with the Inner/Outer Border strips, sew the Alice Toss and the Card People **TOP** strips together. Repeat for the **BOTTOM** and (2) **SIDES**. Look at the Quilt Image for color placement. Press the **SIDE** Strip Sets towards the Inner Border and the **TOP/BOTTOM** Strip Set towards the Outer Border.

On the wrong side of the Quilt Center, place a ¼" mark in each corner. **Diagram 3** Find the center of the (4) Border Strip Sets, mark with a pin on the Inner Border Fabric. Find the center of all four sides of the Quilt Center, mark with a pin. Attach the Border Strip Set to the sides of the Quilt Center, matching the center pins. Sew the Border Strip Set starting at ¼" corner mark and ending at the ¼" corner mark. Leave long thread tails, do not knot or use reverse sewing. DO NOT trim the extra fabric. Repeat on all (4) sides. Press seam in the same direction as the seam in the Border Strip Set. Fold the quilt in half diagonally, right sides together. **Diagram 4** Your extra Border Strip Set fabric should extend to the right. Line up the bottom edge of the Border Strip Set and interlock the Border Strip Set seams, pin in place. Draw a line extending the diagonal fold through the Border Strip Set. This drawn line will be your sew line. The 45° degree line on your ruler is useful at this point. Sew on drawn line, leaving long thread tails, open quilt to make sure that the intersection lays flat. Tie off thread tails. Repeat on remaining (3) corners.

Layering, Quilting and Binding:

Layer backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt and bind as desired.
