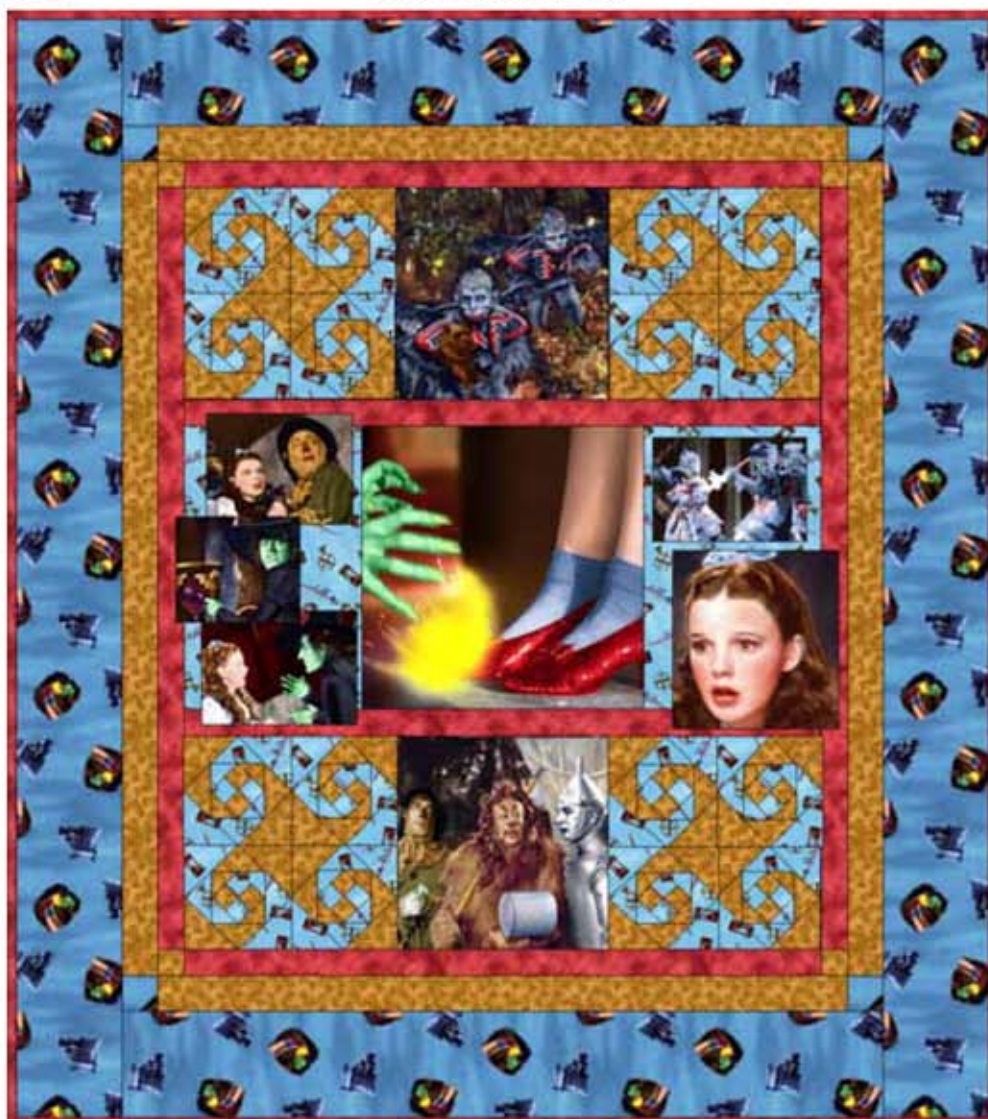

20758-R Border Print

Fussy Cut (2) Images 12½" x 12½" ***

20757-A Filmstrip

Fussy Cut (1) Image 16½" x 16½" ***

***From the above leftover fabric Fussy Cut (5) Images. The sizes are your choice, based on the images chosen.

25709-R Red

Cut (6) 2" x WOF (Width of Fabric) Miter short ends together making one long strip. Subcut (4) 2" x 36½" and (2) 2" x 43½"

Cut (6) 2½" x WOF **BINDING** Miter short ends together making one long strip. Press strip in half lengthwise, wrong sides together.

20762-A Gold Hourglass

Cut (5) 2½" x WOF Miter short ends together making one long strip. Subcut (2) 2½" x 39½" and (2) 2½" x 47½"

Cut (4) 2" x 2" squares from the leftover fabric

Cut (2) 1 9/16" x WOF

Cut (2) 4 3/16" x WOF Subcut (16) 4 3/16" x 4 3/16", cut on the diagonal twice (32) **Piece C**

Cut (1) 2⅝" x WOF Subcut (16) 2⅝" x 2⅝", cut on the diagonal once (32) **Piece B**

Cut (2) 3⅞" x WOF Subcut (16) 3⅞" x 3⅞", cut on the diagonal once (32) **Piece A**

20759-B Sky Castles

Cut (4) 2½" x 2½" squares from the leftover fabric.

Cut (6) 6½" x WOF Miter short ends together making one long strip. Subcut (2) 6½" x 43½" and (2) 6½" x 62½"

20761-B Sky Tools

Cut (2) 3⅞" x WOF Subcut (16) 3⅞" x 3⅞", cut on the diagonal once (32) **Piece A**

Cut (1) 2⅝" x WOF Subcut (16) 2⅝" x 2⅝", cut on the diagonal once (32) **Piece B**

Cut (1) 4 3/16" x WOF Subcut (8) 4 3/16" x 4 3/16", cut on the diagonal twice (32) **Piece C**

Cut (2) 1 9/16" x WOF

Cut (1) 10½" x WOF Subcut (2) 10½" x 16½"

20843-G Green Globes

Cut (2) 2 yard cuts. With fabric right sides together, sew one long selvage edge with a ¼" seam. Trim seam to ¼" and press seam open. **BACKING**

Sewing Directions:

All seams will be pressed towards the fabric just added unless otherwise stated.

Sew the 1 9/16" x WOF, Sky Tools and the Gold Hourglass together lengthwise. Press towards the gold fabric. Subcut into (32) 1 9/16" segments. Sew (2) segments together to make a four patch. **Diagram 1**

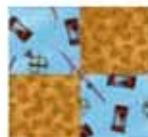

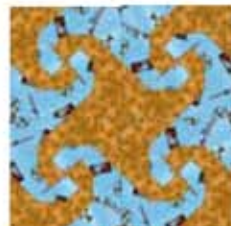

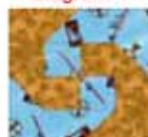

Make 16 6½" x 6½"

Sew **Piece B** on each corner of the four patch. Follow **Diagram 2** for color placement. Sew **Piece C** on each corner of the block. Follow **Diagram 3** for color placement. Repeat with **Piece A**. **Diagram 4** Make (16) blocks. Sew (4) blocks together to make (4) Row Blocks. **Diagram 5**

Row Assembly: (follow quilt image)

Sew a Row Block to each side of the Fussy Cut 12½" x 12½" square. Make (2). Press towards the fussy cut block. Row 1 and Row 3

Sew a 10½" x 16½" Sky Tool to each side of the Fussy Cut 16½" x 16½" square. Press towards the fussy cut block. Row 2

Quilt Center:

Using Rows 1, 2, 3 and the (4) 2" x 36½" Red strips, assemble the Quilt Center per quilt image. Press rows towards the Red strips. Sew the 2" x 2" Gold Hourglass squares to the short ends of the Red 2" x 43½" strips. Sew these strips to the left and right sides of the Quilt Center.

Appliqués:

Apply fusible webbing to the (5) Fussy Cut Images from the Filmstrip fabric. Following the fusible web's manufacture instructions attach the images to the quilt top. Rearrange the images, this is where you make the quilt your own. Top stitch the images in place using your favorite stitch.

Inner and Outer Borders:

Using the Gold Hourglass pieces, sew the (2) 2½" x 39½" strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Sew the (4) 2½" x 2½" Sky Castles squares to the short ends of the (2) 2½" x 47½" pieces. Sew these strips to the left and right sides of the quilt center.

Using the Sky Castles pieces, sew the (2) 6½" x 43½" pieces to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Sew the (2) 6½" x 62½" pieces to the left and right the sides of the quilt center.

Layer, Quilt and Bind:

Using the Green Globe Backing and your favorite method, Layer, Machine Quilt and Bind the quilt.
