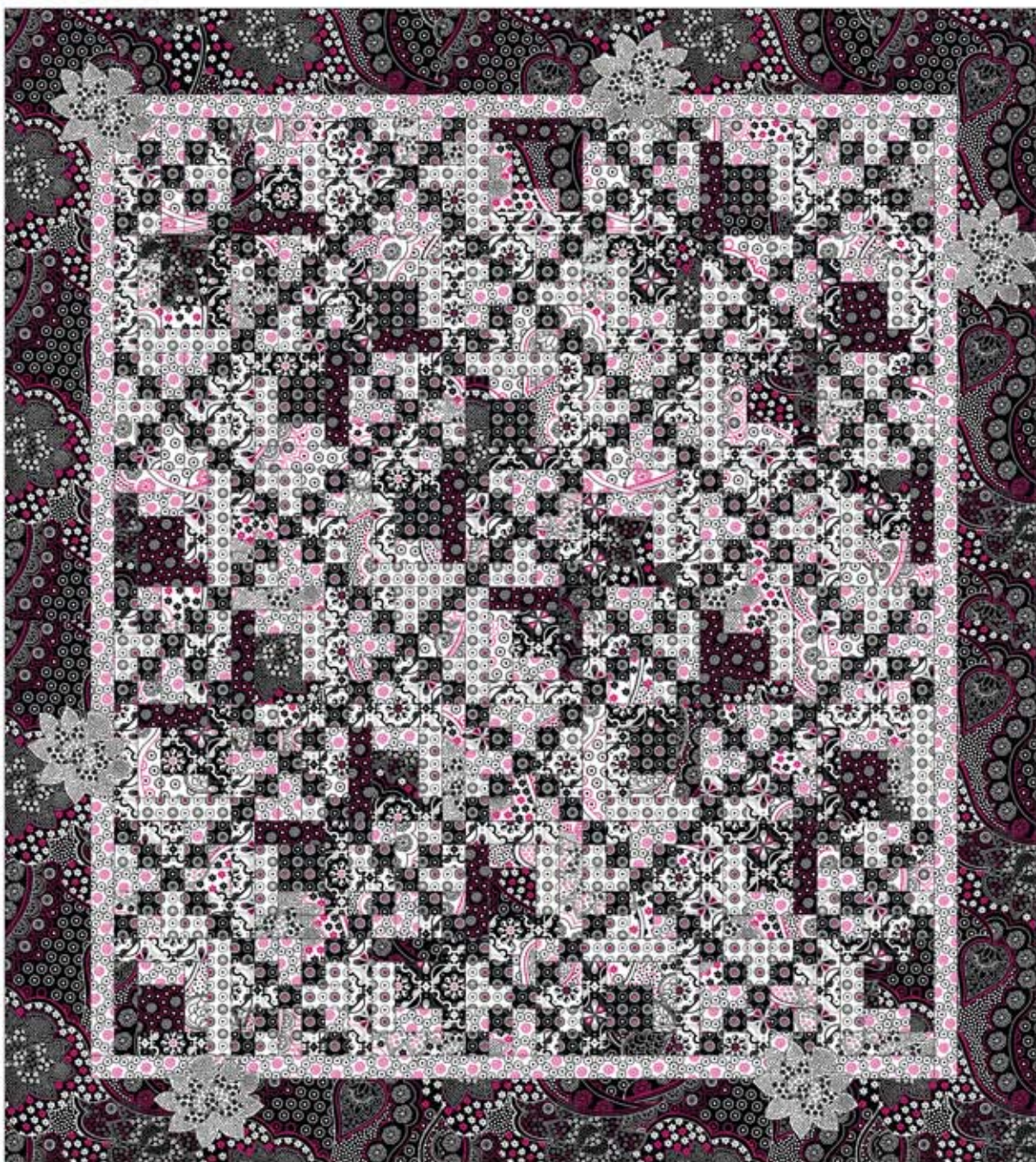
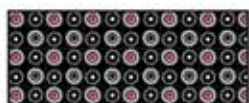

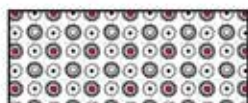

Cutting**Blacks****20696-J**

7 - 5 1/2" x 42" strips (outside border)

7 - 2 1/2" x 42" strips (binding)

20700-J

13 - 2" x 42" strips (chain)

From remaining blacks randomly cut:

28 - 3 1/2" squares

28 - 2" x 5" pieces

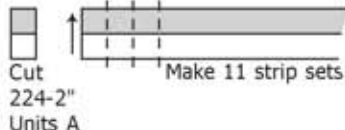
28 - 2" x 6 1/2" pieces

SewingSeam allowances are standard 1/4".
Arrows indicate pressing direction.**Block I**

1. Using 2" x 42" cream and black strips, randomly sew strips together.

Make eleven strip sets.

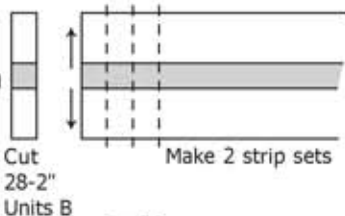
Cut into 224 - 2" Units A.



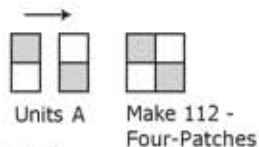
2. Randomly sew one 3 1/2" x 42" cream strip to each side of a 2" x 42" black strip.

Make two strip sets.

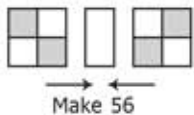
Cut into 28 - 2" Units B.



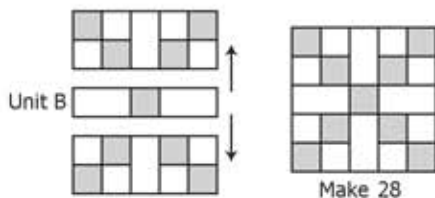
3. Sew two units A together using opposing seams to make 112 - Four Patches.



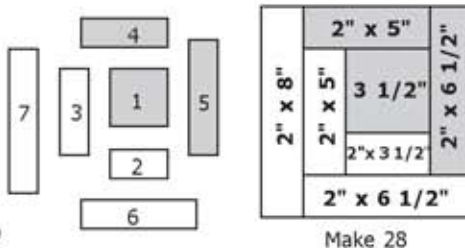
4. Join Four Patches using 2" x 3 1/2" cream pieces.



5. Assemble Block I using Units B.

**Block II**

1. Beginning with the 3 1/2" black square, add cream and black pieces in number order and sizes given. Press to outside.

**Creams****20713-ZJ**

6 - 1 1/2" x 42" strips (accent border)

20715-ZJ

1 - 71" x 78" piece (backing)

Piece backing before cutting out applique flowers

6 - fussy cut flowers for applique (hand or heat & bond)

From remaining creams randomly cut:

56 - 3 1/2" x 2" pieces

11 - 2" x 42" strips

4 - 3 1/2" x 42" strips

28 - 2" x 3 1/2" pieces

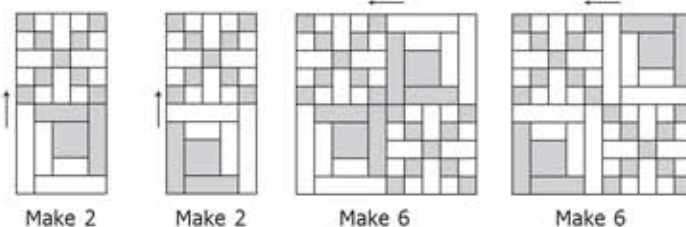
28 - 2" x 5" pieces

28 - 2" x 6 1/2" pieces

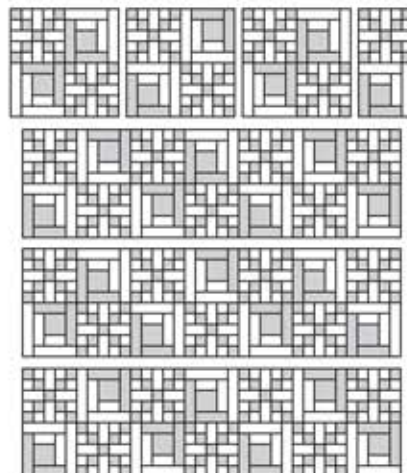
28 - 2" x 8" pieces

Assembly

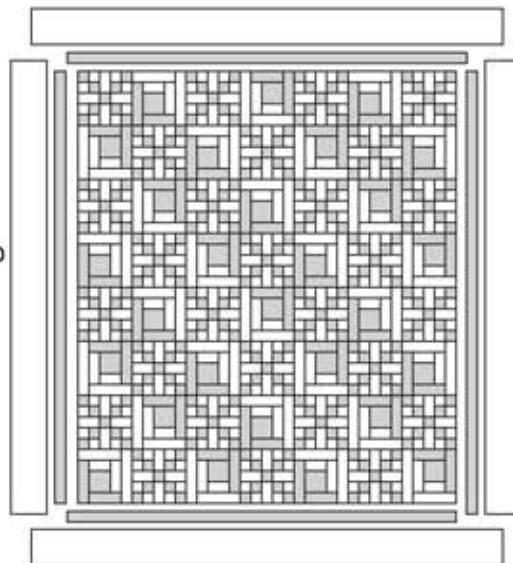
1. Using illustration below, make the following single block units and Four-Patch units.



2. Using Illustration as guide, join single and Four-Patch units to assemble rows. Press rows in opposite directions. Join rows together.



3. Sew 1 1/2" accent border strips to each side of quilt, then top and bottom. Press to accent border.



4. Sew 5" border strips to each side of quilt, then top and bottom. Press to border.

5. Add applique flowers using your favorite method.

6. Layer, quilt, and bind.
