Skill level –Intermediate

Cutting:

21485-A – Leaving $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance around each image and including the words beneath each image; fussy cut four boy scout images.

21492-R – Cut eight-5" x 13" rectangles. Cut eight- $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x 17" rectangles. Cut seven strips- $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x 42". Subcut strips into 80- $3\frac{3}{8}$ " squares. Cut each square on the diagonal to make 160-half square triangles. Cut four- $4\frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Cut one- $8\frac{3}{4}$ " square. Subcut $8\frac{3}{4}$ "-square into four quarter-square triangles.

21488-R –Cut five- $5\frac{3}{4}$ " squares.

21488-Y - Cut 2 strips- $4\frac{5}{8}$ " x 42". Subcut strips into 16- $4\frac{5}{8}$ " squares. Subcut squares into 32-half square triangles.

21492-E– Cut 16- $4\frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Cut four- $8\frac{3}{4}$ " squares. Subcut $8\frac{3}{4}$ "-squares into 16 quarter-square triangles.

21491-G- Cut 18- $5\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Cut two $4\frac{5}{8}$ " squares. Subcut 2- $4\frac{5}{8}$ " squares into 4-half square triangles.

21489-R– Cut 6 strips 3" x 42".

21491-E- Cut 2 strips- $4\frac{5}{8}$ " x 42". Subcut strips into 12- $4\frac{5}{8}$ " squares. Subcut squares into 24-half square triangles. Cut 6 strips-3" x 42". Subcut 3" strips into 80- $3\frac{3}{8}$ " squares. Cut three strips- $6\frac{1}{4}$ " x 42". Subcut $6\frac{1}{4}$ " strips into 20- $6\frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Subcut $6\frac{1}{4}$ " squares into 80-quarter square triangles.

21492-Y- Cut 6 strips-3" x 42". Subcut 3" strips into 72-3" squares. Cut three strips- $6\frac{1}{4}$ " x 42". Subcut $6\frac{1}{4}$ " strips into 18- $6\frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Subcut $6\frac{1}{4}$ " squares into 72-quarter square triangles.

21490-R- Cut six strips- $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x 42". Subcut strips into 72- $3\frac{3}{8}$ " squares. Cut each square on the diagonal to make 144-half square triangles. Cut nine strips- $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" for binding.

21487-E- Cut 20- $5\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Piece quilt back from remaining yardage.

Construction:

Sew with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance and all fabrics right sides together. Press each seam toward the darker fabric as you sew.

Center of Quilt

1. Sew 21492-R 5" x 13" rectangles to sides of 21485-A images, note that the 21492-R strips are oversized. Trim strips flush with tops and bottoms of images. Sew 21492-R $3\frac{1}{4}$ x 17" rectangles to tops and bottoms of 21485-A images. Trim blocks to measure $15\frac{1}{2}$ " square, centering images.

2. Sew four 21491-G quarter square triangles to all sides of one 21488-R square. Make flying geese units from 21492-R quarter square triangles and 21491-E half square triangles. Assemble the quilt center block using the center square, flying geese and 21492-R $4\frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Block should measure $15\frac{1}{2}$ " square

3. Sew four 21491-E half square triangles to all sides of four 21488-R squares. Make flying geese units from 21492-E quarter square triangles and 21488-Y half square triangles. Assemble four star blocks using the center squares, flying geese and 21492-E $4\frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Blocks should measure $15\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

4. Referring to quilt diagram, assemble center nine-patch section of quilt. Quilt center should measure $45\frac{1}{2}$ " x $45\frac{1}{2}$ ".

5. Sew six 21489-R 3" x 42" strips together end-to-end with diagonal seams. Cut two strips $45\frac{1}{2}$ " long and sew them to sides of quilt. Cut two strips $50\frac{1}{2}$ " long and sew them to the top and bottom of quilt. Quilt center should measure $50\frac{1}{2}$ " x $50\frac{1}{2}$ ".

6. Make flying geese units from 21491-E quarter square triangles and 21492-R half square triangles. With 21487-E $5\frac{1}{2}$ " squares as block centers, use flying geese units and 21491-E 3" squares to assemble 20 ecru star blocks. Each block should measure $10\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

7. Make flying geese units from 21492-Y quarter square triangles and 21490-R half square triangles. With 21491-G $5\frac{1}{2}$ " squares as block centers, use flying geese units and 21492-Y 3" squares to assemble 18 blue star blocks. Each block should measure $10\frac{1}{2}$ " square

8. Referring to quilt diagram, alternate two blue star blocks and three ecru star blocks to make a strip. Make a total of two strips. Sew strips to sides of quilt center.

9. Referring to quilt diagram, alternate blue star blocks ecru star blocks to make a two star panels that are each seven stars wide and two stars high. Sew panels to the top and bottom of quilt center, being careful to alternate star colors.

Layer and quilt as desired.

Binding:

Sew ends of 21490-R binding strips together with straight seams. Fold assembled strip in half lengthwise and press. Sew binding to right side of quilt, mitering corners. Turn binding to the back of the quilt and slipstitch in place.
